## Examination of credentials of representatives, substitutes and special guests

Report  
President of the Assembly

1. In accordance with Rule 6, paragraphs 1, 2 and 4, of the Rules of Procedure, the President of the Assembly has received the credentials of new representatives and substitutes for the 4<sup>th</sup> part of the 2004 Ordinary Session of the Assembly, which have been transmitted in due form by the competent authorities of eight member states.
2. *Austria* has appointed a new substitute to replace Mrs Schicker, who has resigned.
3. *The Czech Republic* has appointed two new representatives to replace MM. Ouzký and Ransdorf and two new substitutes to replace MM. Cabmoch and Maštálka, who have resigned.
4. *Finland* has appointed a new representative to replace Mr Takkula and a new substitute to replace Mrs Jäätteenmäki, who have resigned.
5. *Hungary* has appointed four new representatives to replace MM. Tabajdi and Hegyi, Mrs Kósa-Kovács and Mr Surján, who have resigned. Three new substitutes have been appointed to replace Mrs Herczog, who has resigned, and MM. Braun and Gedei, who have been appointed representatives.
6. *Iceland* has appointed one new representative to replace Mr Gunnarsson, who has resigned, and one substitute to replace Mr Ámason, who has resigned.
7. *The Netherlands* have appointed a new substitute to replace Mr Kortenhorst, who has resigned.
8. *Poland* has appointed three new representatives to replace MM Libicki, Gierek and Giertych, who have resigned. Mr Rzymek, former substitute, has been appointed representative to replace Mr Klich, who has resigned. Two new substitutes have been appointed to replace Mr Grabowski, who has resigned, and Mr Rzymek.
9. *Slovakia* has appointed three new representatives to replace Mrs Bauer and Mrs Belohorská, who have resigned, and to replace Mr Banáš who has been appointed substitute. Three new substitutes have been appointed to replace MM Duka-Zólyomi, Figeľ and Miššik, who have resigned.
10. The Assembly is called upon to express its decision on the validation of the credentials of the members whose names are given below.
11. In the case of objection or justified contestation, the contested credentials shall be referred without debate to the appropriate committee which shall report back to the Assembly, in accordance with Rules 7 and 8 of the Rules of Procedure.
