Examination of credentials of Representatives, Substitutes and Special Guests

Supplementary report presented by the President of the Assembly

- 1. Following the examination of credentials of new representatives, substitutes and special guests appointed at the 4th part of the 2004 session of the Assembly, credentials certified by the competent authorities of six member states have been transmitted to the President of the Assembly for validation by the Standing Committee acting on behalf of the Assembly.
- 2. Belgium has appointed two new substitutes to replace MM. Ramoudt and Timmermans, who have resigned. Two new representatives have been appointed to replace MM. De Decker and Poty, who have resigned.
- 3. France has appointed three new substitutes to replace Mr Masseret, who has been appointed representative, and MM. Masson and Pintat, who have resigned. Three new representatives have been appointed to replace MM. Debarge and Delattre, who have resigned, and Mr Le Grand, who has been appointed substitute.
- Germany has appointed one new representative to replace Mrs Wegener, who has resigned.
- 5. Greece has appointed one new substitute to replace Mr Stathakis, who has resigned.
- 6. Monaco has appointed a new delegation.
- 7. The Netherlands have appointed two new substitutes to replace MM. Brinkel and Szabó, who have resigned. One new representative has been appointed to replace Mr van Baalen, who has resigned.
- 8. The Standing Committee, acting on behalf of the Assembly, is called upon to express its decision on the validation of the credentials of the members whose names are given below.
- 9. In the case of objection or justified contestation, the contested credentials shall be referred without debate to the appropriate committee which shall report back to the Assembly, in accordance with Rules 7 and 8 of the Rules of Procedure.
