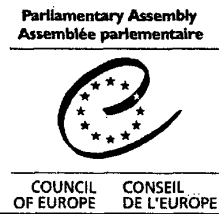

MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS

Mr René van der Linden, President of the Assembly, took the Chair at 3.05 p.m.

1. MINUTES

The Minutes of the eleventh sitting were adopted.

2. ATTENDANCE REGISTER

The names of the Representatives, Substitutes and Observers who signed the attendance register are given in the Appendix.

3. ELECTION OF A JUDGE TO THE EUROPEAN COURT OF HUMAN RIGHTS IN RESPECT OF LATVIA

The result of voting in the ballot for the election of a judge to the European Court of Human Rights in respect of Latvia was declared as follows:

The President announced that Mrs Ziemele, having obtained an absolute majority of votes cast, was elected a member of the European Court of Human Rights for a term of office starting that day and continuing until 31 October 2007.

4. ADDRESS BY MR JEAN-CLAUDE JUNCKER, PRIME MINISTER OF LUXEMBOURG AND PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION

The President welcomed Mr Juncker, Prime Minister of Luxembourg and President of the Council of the European Union.

Mr Juncker addressed the Assembly and answered questions from MM Elo, Van den Brande, Eörsi, Kvakkestad, Schreiner, Zernovski, Jaskiernia, Iwiński, Szabó, Kosachev, Tulaev, Slutsky, Gardetto, Mrs Hoffmann, MM Gross, Nami, Mercan.

The President thanked Mr Juncker.

5. DISCRIMINATION AGAINST WOMEN

The Report of the Committee on Equal Opportunities for Women and Men on discrimination against women in the workforce and the workplace (Doc. 10484) was presented by Mrs Čurdová, Rapporteur.

Mrs Severinsen, a Vice-President of the Assembly, took the Chair in place of Mr van der Linden.

The Report of the Committee on Equal Opportunities for Women and Men on discrimination against women and girls in sport (Doc. 10483) was presented by Mrs Cliveti, Chairperson of the Committee.

The joint debate was opened.

Speakers: Mrs Zapfl-Helbling, Mrs Pericleous Papadopoulos, Mr Platvoet, Mrs Vermot-Mangold, Mrs Hurskainen, Mrs Grosskost, Mr Branger, Ms Pasternak, Mr Schneider, Mrs Bilgehan, Mrs Ahlqvist, Mrs Damanaki, Mrs Losier-Cool.

Mrs Cliveti, Chairperson of the Committee on Equal Opportunities for Women and Men and Mrs Čurdová, Rapporteur, replied to the joint debate.

The joint debate was closed.

The Assembly agreed the draft recommendation contained in Doc. 10484 (*Recommendation 1700 (2005)*).

The Assembly considered the draft recommendation contained in Doc. 10483.

The President announced that the amendments to the draft recommendation would be considered in numbered order.

An amendment (No. 1) was proposed by Mr André Schneider, Lord Russell-Johnston, Mr Joseph Falzon, Mr Christophe Spiliotis-Saquet, Mr Jacques Legendre, Mrs Anne Brasseur, Mr Jerzy Smorawiński, Mr Johannes Randegger, in the draft recommendation, at the beginning of paragraph 1, replace the words "Women suffer" with the words:

"Almost ten years after its Resolution 1092(96) on discrimination against women in the field of sport and more particularly in the Olympic Games, the Assembly is distressed to observe that women still suffer".

Speakers: Mr Schneider, Mrs Cliveti.

The amendment was agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 2) was proposed by Mr André Schneider, Lord Russell-Johnston, Mr Joseph Falzon, Mr Christophe Spiliotis-Saquet, Mr Jacques Legendre, Mrs Anne Brasseur, Mr Jerzy Smorawiński, Mr Johannes Randegger, in the draft recommendation, after paragraph 4, add the following paragraph:

"The involvement of the Council of Europe on the issue of women's participation in sport started however much earlier, in 1980, with the seminar on "a greater involvement of women in sport" organised by the Committee for the Development of Sport (CDDS). As a result of this, and of other similar initiatives, the network "European Women and Sport" (EWS) was created. The subject has been discussed in Ministerial conferences by the Council of Europe and Unesco from 1981 to 2004. The IOC also organised three World Conferences on the topic."

Speakers: Mr Schneider, Mrs Cliveti.

The amendment was agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 3) was proposed by Mr André Schneider, Lord Russell-Johnston, Mr Joseph Falzon, Mr Christophe Spiliotis-Saquet, Mr Jacques Legendre, Mrs Anne Brasseur, Mr Jerzy Smorawiński, Mr Johannes Randegger, in the draft recommendation, after paragraph 4, insert the following paragraph:

"The Assembly welcomes the work of the Council of Europe, the CDDS, Unesco, the IOC, the EWS and of all bodies, at national, European and international level, to combat discrimination against women and girls and to promote their participation in sport. In this context it supports the Brighton Declaration (1994), the Windhoek (1998) and Paris (2004) Calls for Action and the Berlin Memorandum (2002)."

Speakers: Mr Schneider, Mrs Cliveti.

The amendment was agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 4) was proposed by Mr André Schneider, Lord Russell-Johnston, Mr Joseph Falzon, Mr Christophe Spiliotis-Saquet, Mr Jacques Legendre, Mrs Anne Brasseur, Mr Jerzy Smorawiński, Mr Johannes Randegger, in the draft recommendation, paragraph 5.i, replace the words "instruct the competent intergovernmental committee to make an in-depth study of national sport policies and their impact on women's and girls' participation in sports activities and work out a "European Strategy for Women and Sport", which should ensure:" with the following words:

"encourage the CDDS to continue, in cooperation with other relevant bodies, to promote the participation of women and girls in sport, to combat discrimination against women and girls in sport and to ensure:"

Speaker: Mr Schneider.

An oral sub-amendment, to the amendment, was proposed by Mr André Schneider, replace the proposed text of amendment No. 4 with the following text:

"instruct the CDDS to continue, in cooperation with other relevant bodies, to promote the participation of women and girls in sport, to combat discrimination against women and girls in sport and to make an in-depth study of national sport policies and their impact on women's and girls' participation in sports activities and to work out a "European Strategy for Women and Sport", which should ensure:"

The President declared that the oral sub-amendment did meet the criteria of Rule 34.6a.

Speaker: Mrs Cliveti.

The oral sub-amendment was agreed to.

The amendment, as amended, was agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 5) was proposed by Mr André Schneider, Lord Russell-Johnston, Mr Joseph Falzon, Mr Christophe Spiliotis-Saquet, Mr Jacques Legendre, Mrs Anne Brasseur, Mr Jerzy Smorawiński, Mr Johannes Randegger, in the draft recommendation, delete paragraph 5.ii.

Speakers: Mr Schneider, Mrs Cliveti.

The amendment was not agreed to.

The Assembly agreed the draft recommendation contained in Doc. 10483, as amended, (*Recommendation 1701 (2005)*).

Mr Iwiński, a Vice-President of the Assembly, took the Chair in place of Mrs Severinsen.

6. MIGRATION AND INTEGRATION: A CHALLENGE AND AN OPPORTUNITY FOR EUROPE

The Report of the Committee on Migration, Refugees and Population on migration and integration: a challenge and an opportunity for Europe (Doc. 10453) was presented by Mr Branger, Rapporteur.

The debate was opened.

Mr Branger, Rapporteur of the Committee on Migration, Refugees and Population and Mr Wilkinson, Chairperson of the Committee replied to the debate.

The debate was closed.

The Assembly considered the draft resolution contained in Doc. 10453.

The President announced that the amendments to the draft resolution would be considered in the following order: Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 5, 6, 7.

An amendment (No. 1) was proposed by Mrs Tana de Zulueta, Mrs Carina Hägg, Mrs Majléne Westerlund Panke, Mrs Ruth-Gaby Vermot-Mangold, Lord Frank Judd, Mrs Josette Durrieu, Mr Franco Danieli, Mrs Carina Ohlsson, in the draft resolution, paragraph 2, after the word "immigrants", replace the words "the most" with the word:

"a".

The amendment was agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 2) was proposed by Mrs Tana de Zulueta, Mrs Carina Hägg, Mrs Majléne Westerlund Panke, Mrs Ruth-Gaby Vermot-Mangold, Lord Frank Judd, Mrs Josette Durrieu, Mr Franco Danieli, Mrs Carina Ohlsson, in the draft resolution, paragraph 2, after the word "societies", replace the words "such as" with the words:

"as codified by the European Convention on Human Rights, including".

"the laws and".

The amendment was agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 4) was proposed by Mrs Tana de Zulueta, Mrs Carina Hägg, Mrs Majléne Westerlund Panke, Mrs Ruth-Gaby Vermot-Mangold, Lord Frank Judd, Mrs Josette Durrieu, Mr Franco Danieli, Mrs Carina Ohlsson, in the draft resolution, paragraph 6, replace the words "Those obligations" with the following words :

"The Assembly has emphasized the importance, within the context of national integration strategies, of extending voting rights to legal immigrants, in compliance with the 1992 Convention of the Participation of Foreigners in Public Life at Local Level. The above obligations".

The amendment was agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 8) was proposed by Mr Mevlüt Çavuşoğlu, Mr Ali Rıza Gülçiçek, Mrs Tana de Zulueta, Lord Frank Judd, Mrs Ruth-Gaby Vermot-Mangold, in the draft resolution, after paragraph 9.i.b, insert the following sub-paragraph:

"recognise immigrants as persons with fundamental human rights, the respect of which must be ensured in full conformity with international and regional human rights instruments including the provisions of the International Convention on the Protection of the Rights of All Migrant Workers and Members of their Families which Member States are urged to ratify and implement;"

The amendment was agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 5) was proposed by Mrs Tana de Zulueta, Mrs Carina Hägg, Mrs Majléne Westerlund Panke, Mrs Ruth-Gaby Vermot-Mangold, Lord Frank Judd, Mrs Josette Durrieu, Mr Franco Danieli, Mrs Carina Ohlsson, in the draft resolution, paragraph 9.iii, replace the words "on the basis of a selection on objective criteria which take account of" with the following words:

"taking into account".

The amendment was agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 6) was proposed by Mrs Tana de Zulueta, Mrs Carina Hägg, Mrs Majléne Westerlund Panke, Mrs Ruth-Gaby Vermot-Mangold, Lord Frank Judd, Mrs Josette Durrieu, Mr Franco Danieli, Mrs Carina Ohlsson, in the draft resolution, paragraph 9.v, replace the words "culture, traditions and integration objectives" with the words:

"culture and traditions".

The amendment was agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 7) was proposed by Mrs Tana de Zulueta, Mrs Carina Hägg, Mrs Majléne Westerlund Panke, Mrs Ruth-Gaby Vermot-Mangold, Lord Frank Judd, Mrs Josette Durrieu, Mr Franco Danieli, Mrs Carina Ohlsson, in the draft resolution, after paragraph 9.v, insert the following sub-paragraph:

"sign and ratify the 1992 Council of Europe Convention on the Participation of Foreigners in Public Life at Local level;"

Speakers: Mrs Vermont-Mangold, Mr Wilkinson.

The amendment was agreed to.

The Assembly agreed the draft resolution contained in Doc. 10453, as amended, (*Resolution 1437 (2005)*).
