Transportation

Participants arriving at Tromsø airport on 11 May 2005 will be offered bus transportation to the hotels. Participants leaving for the airport after the conference on the 14 or 15 May 2005 will also be offered transportation.

Air travel to Tromsø includes transit through Oslo international airport, where passengers need to walk (indoors) from the international to the domestic terminal. Checked-in luggage will proceed automatically to Tromsø. There will be a special information desk at Oslo airport to assist the conference participants.

Transportation in Tromsø No transportation is needed between the conference hotels. Bus transportation will be provided for the reception on 12 May, excursion 14 May and accompanying persons' programme.

Currency

Cash payments in Norway can only be made in *Norwegian krone* (NOK). Credit cards, particularly VISA and MasterCard, are accepted in all hotels and in almost all shops, and can be used to withdraw cash from ATMs.

Climate

Tromsø is located above the polar circle. The average temperature in May is around +4 degrees centigrade although the actual temperature can be up to 10 degrees above or below that. Solar radiation is strong particularly near snow. Bring a warm winter coat and shoes – but do not forget dark sunglasses.
