Programme

The Conference on "Democracy and Good Governance in Multi-Ethnic Societies as a basis for Stability and Security" will begin at 09:30 on Friday 7 October and conclude at 12:30 on Saturday 8 October.

The Standing Committee will meet from 15:00 to 18:00 on Saturday 8 October.

The Third Parliamentary Forum on the Mediterranean will meet on Sunday 9 October from 10:00 until 18:00.

An excursion is programmed for the morning of Monday 10 October followed by a lunch.

Detailed programmes will be distributed to all delegations in due time

Registration

The registration and information desk will be open on October 6 to October 10 from 09.00 to 18.00 at hotel "Maestral".

All participants and accompanying persons are kindly requested to register at the desk where they will receive their identification badges. Participants may be required to show an official identification when registering (passport or identity card).

Visa requirements:

Identification:

For security purposes, participants are requested to wear their identity badges at all meetings and social functions. Name badges will be needed to access to all Conference events.

Lost of identity badges should be reported immediately to the conference staff.

Badges are in the following colors:

Blue: Head/Member/Staff of Delegation, Guest Speakers/International Secretariat

Orange: Accompanying persons

Yellow: Press

Accompanying persons program:

A program for accompanying persons has been arranged while delegations are engaged in conference sessions. Accompanying persons are kindly requested to wear their identity badges at all times.

Interpretation will be provided in seven languages (six official OSCE languages + language of the host country). No translation service will be available.

Transportation:

Transportation from and to the Airports in Tivat and Podgorica, as well as to social events and the excursion, will be provided by the Parliament of the Republic of Montenegro.

Transportation will also be provided to and from the Airport Cilipi in Dubrovnik, Croatia.

Note: Participants who decide to arrive in Dubrovnik need to check entry visa requirements of the Republic of Croatia.

There will be desks at Tivat and Podgorica Airports (as well as in Airport Cilipi, Croatia) with the OSCE logo to help delegates to the buses. Please note that the service will be available at the arrival on October 6 and at the departure on 9 and 10 of October.

Excursion:

On Monday, October 10, 2005 a cruise through the Bay of Boka Kotorska is scheduled for the participants and the accompanying persons. The dress is informal.

Cruise will last around 4 hours.

Climate:

Climate at this period of the year on the coast of Montenegro is mild with average temperatures from 20 to 30 Celsius.
