My name is professor Rumen Valchev- director of an Open Education Centre - NGO in the field of Civic Education , former deputy minister of education in Bulgaria.

In the years 2000 and 2001 I organized on Bulgarian side two study visits for Bulgarian Educators to Denmark supported by the Danish Fund for Democracy.

On Danish side the visits has been organized by mr. Carl Vilbaek.

During the visits we had the idea to approach the Danish Fund for a somewhat bigger but far more interesting educational project - elaboration of Global Education Curriculum for the students from South-Eastern Europe.

We had an opportunity to observe the Global Education developments in Denmark and as well we discussed this idea with educators from Albania and Moldova who as well participated in such study visits.
