Let me first introduce myself. I am prof. Rumen Valchev, from Bourgas Free University and director of the biggest Bulgarian NGO in the field of Civic Education Open Education Centre and former deputy minister of education .

In 2000 and 2001 together with mr.Carl Vilbaek and with the kind support of the Danish Fund of Democracy we did organize two study visits of about 50 Bulgarian educators to Denmark.

By that time we began to explore the idea of a joint Balkan project which will serve the peaceful cooperation between the countries in the region, will be based on the Danish expertise in the field of Civic and Global Education.

We did apply to the Danish Fund of Democracy, but due to the changes, without success and now with the announcement of the Strategic Framework for the Neighbourhood programme we would like once again to present the idea of elaboration of a joint Global Education and European Citizenship curriculum.

As much as I'm aware this is a unique project in the history of the education in our region which could have a chance to develop in a long term sustainable international educational effort.

I do count on your understanding and do hope that if I do have an opportunity for a meeting I will be able to present in more details the idea.

### **General background:**

As it is pointed out in the Neighbourhood programme "...Europe leaves behind it the 20th century's unnatural divisions of the continent: east and the west are united in a common vision of peace, stability and democracy for the citizens of a whole Europe.."

Education and especially the co-operation between the educators and the joint development of programs are among the most promising futures of the coming new European order.

1.In the last years there are some important developments in the South-Eastern European countries in the field of development of new approaches in the field of Civic Education, Intercultural Education, Education for Human Rights, Peace and Tolerance.

Many projects have been realized and new curriculum has been elaborated.

- 2. Many developments have become reality because of the support of the Danish Fund for Democracy / educational study visits of educators from Moldova, Albania, Bulgaria to Denmark
- 3. There is a need in the Region for elaboration of joint approaches, of collaborative efforts in the field of the social studies, of elaboration of materials. Only in this way the intercultural differences should be overcome and the education of the young people in the European spirit and values will become possible.
- 4. The Global Education topics of Human Rights, Peace, Tolerance, Poverty, Social Justice, new European and world order, communication technologies and cet. Are one of the possible ways to build an common educational approach.
- 5. Denmark is the country where these approaches in the field of Global Education are the most advanced not only in Europe.

The joint work of educators and curriculum developers from SEE and from Denmark could have for a result a manual on Global Education and European Citizenship relevant for SEE which could be a solid foundation for further co-operative efforts.

## **Objectives:**

- 1.Development of a Global Education and European Citizenship curriculum relevant for SEE based on the efforts and the experience of the educators from the Region and on the support and on methodologies developed in Denmark.
- 2. Elaboration of a co-operative model of work between the educators from SEE Europe and initiation of a network of educators in the field of Global Education.
  - 3. Fruitful transfer of experience from Denmark to SEE.
- 4.Involvement of the young people in the process of elaboration of Global Education and European Citizenship materials
