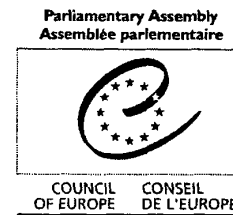

MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS

Mr René van der Linden, President of the Assembly, took the Chair at 10.15 a.m.

1. ATTENDANCE REGISTER

The names of the Representatives, Substitutes and Observers who signed the attendance register are given in the Appendix.

2. MINUTES

The minutes of the sixth sitting were agreed to.

3. WRITTEN DECLARATIONS

The President announced that, in accordance with Rule 53 of the Rules of Procedure, two written declarations had been printed. The first declaration (No. 374) on the situation of the Serbs expelled from the Republic Serbian Krajina (UN Protected Area) and the Republic of Croatia in 1990-1995 had been signed by 28 Members of the Assembly. The second declaration (No. 375) on the situation in Cyprus had been signed by 75 Members of the Assembly.

Representatives or Substitutes who wished to add their signatures to these declarations could do so in the Table Office. If any names were added, the declarations would be distributed again two weeks after the end of the part-session with all the accumulated signatures.

4. CHANGES IN THE MEMBERSHIP OF COMMITTEES

The Assembly ratified the changes in the membership of committees as set out in documents Commissions (2006) 1 Addendum 4 and Addendum 5.

5. RELOCATION OF ECONOMIC ACTIVITIES ABROAD AND EUROPEAN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

The Report of the Committee on Economic Affairs and Development on relocation of economic activities abroad and European economic development (Doc. 10757) was presented by Mr Neven Mimica, Rapporteur.

The debate was opened.

Speaker: Mr John Dupraz.

Mrs Elsa Papadimitriou, a Vice-President of the Assembly, took the chair in place of Mr René van der Linden

Mr Neven Mimica, Rapporteur, and Mr Evgeni Kirilov, Chairperson of the Committee on Economic Affairs and Development, replied to the debate.

The debate was closed.

The Assembly agreed to the draft resolution contained in Doc. 10757 (*Resolution 1484 (2006)*).

Mr Bernard Schreiner, a Vice-President of the Assembly, took the chair in place of Mrs Elsa Papadimitriou.

6. IMPLICATIONS FOR EUROPE OF THE ECONOMIC RESURGENCE OF CHINA

The Report of the Committee on Economic Affairs and Development on the implications for Europe of the economic resurgence of China (Doc. 10756) was presented by Mr Paul Wille, Rapporteur

The debate was opened.

Mr Paul Wille, Rapporteur, and Mr Evgeni Kirilov, Chairperson of the Committee on Economic Affairs and Development, replied to the debate.

The debate was closed.

The Assembly considered the draft resolution contained in Doc. 10756.

The President announced that the amendments to the draft resolution would be taken in numerical order.

An amendment (No. 1) was proposed by Mr José Mendes Bota, Mrs Maria de Belém Roseira, Mr Piotr Wach, Mr Egidijus Vareikis, Mr Domenico Contestabile, in the draft resolution, after paragraph 3, to insert the following paragraph:

"The Parliamentary Assembly cannot overlook the fact that there is inadequate respect for the social rights of Chinese workers, and stresses that to a large extent China's economy is growing as a result of a development model based on low wages and exploitation of the labour force, in a political single-party context in which there is a total lack of democratic parliamentary control.",

The amendment was not agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 2) was proposed by Mr José Mendes Bota, Mrs Maria de Belém Roseira, Mr Piotr Wach, Mr Egidijus Vareikis, Mr Domenico Contestabile, in the draft resolution, paragraph 6, replace the first sentence with the following sentence:

"The Assembly is aware that the invasion of Chinese products onto the European market, particularly in the textile and manufactured goods sector and the rapidly increasing control of retail outlets based in Europe are among the main reasons for the bankruptcy and closure of thousands of factories in Europe and a worrying rise in the unemployment rate in the European labour force.",

Speakers: Mr José Mendes Bota, Mr Göran Lindblad, Mr Evgeni Kirilov.

The amendment was not agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 3) was proposed by Mr José Mendes Bota, Mrs Maria de Belém Roseira, Mr Piotr Wach, Mr Egidijus Vareikis, Mr Domenico Contestabile, in the draft resolution, paragraph 7, replace the words "to pay greater attention to the wider implications" with the following words: "to take on board the positive and negative consequences for Europe"

Speakers: Mr José Mendes Bota, Mr Stef Goris, Mr Evgeni Kirilov.

The amendment was agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 4) was proposed by Mr José Mendes Bota, Mrs Maria de Belém Roseira, Mr Piotr Wach, Mr Egidijus Vareikis, Mr Domenico Contestabile, in the draft resolution, paragraph 7, replace the words "attentively to follow further developments" with the following words: "to ask member states to pay much greater attention to developments in the situation when taking decisions at economic and financial level".

The amendment was agreed to.

The Assembly agreed to the draft resolution contained in Doc. 10756, as amended (*Resolution 1485 (2006)*).

7. DRAFT PROTOCOL ON THE AVOIDANCE OF STATELESSNESS IN RELATION TO STATE SUCCESSION

The Report of the Committee on Legal Affairs and Human Rights on the draft protocol on the avoidance of statelessness in relation to state succession (Doc. 10770), drawn up following a request from the Committee of Ministers for an opinion (Doc. 10646) was presented by Mr Jaume Bartumeu Cassany, Rapporteur.

The debate was opened.

Speakers: Mrs Renate Wohlwend, Ms Elmira Akhundova, Mr André Schneider.

Mr Jaume Bartumeu Cassany, Rapporteur, and Mr Dick Marty, Chairperson of the Committee on Legal Affairs and Human Rights, replied to the debate.

The debate was closed.

The Assembly considered the draft opinion contained in Doc. 10770.

An amendment (No. 1) was proposed by Mr Yuri Sharandin, Mrs Natalia Narochinskaya, Mr Leonid Slutsky, Mr Valery Grebennikov, Mr Igor Chernyshenko, in the draft opinion, after paragraph 3, to insert the following paragraph:

"The Assembly regrets that, according to Article 14 of the draft Protocol, the Protocol will only apply to situations of state succession which will take place after its entry into force. The Assembly recalls a widely accepted principle of law according to which rules that offer a more favourable regime for individuals should have a retroactive effect. This is particularly important in view of the high number of persons deprived of nationality as a result of the cases of state succession that occurred in Europe the late 1980s and early 1990s.",

The amendment was agreed to.

The Assembly agreed to the draft opinion contained in Doc. 10770, as amended (*Opinion 258 (2006)*).
