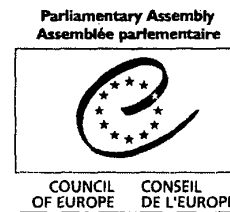

MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS

Mr René van der Linden took the Chair at 3.00 p.m.

1. RESUMPTION OF THE SESSION

The President declared the second part of the 2006 Ordinary Session resumed.

2. ATTENDANCE REGISTER

The names of the Representatives, Substitutes and Observers who signed the attendance register are given in the Appendix.

3. ADDRESS BY THE PRESIDENT TO THE ASSEMBLY

The President addressed the Assembly.

4. EXAMINATION OF CREDENTIALS

The President presented the Report on the examination of the credentials of Representatives and Substitutes (Doc. 10866).

The credentials contained in Doc. 10866 were ratified.

5. CHANGES IN MEMBERSHIP OF COMMITTEES

The Assembly ratified the changes in the membership of committees as set out in Commissions (2006) 4.

6. ELECTION OF VICE-PRESIDENT OF THE ASSEMBLY

The President announced that he had received the nomination of Mr Giorgi Bokeria on behalf of Georgia for election as Vice-President of the Assembly.

There being no objection, he was duly elected, in accordance with Rule 14(4) of the Rules of Procedure.

7. REQUESTS FOR URGENT PROCEDURE

There had been a request for an urgent debate, in accordance with Rule 50 of the Rules of Procedure, entitled *Stop trafficking in women before the FIFA World Cup*.

The President informed the Assembly of the recommendation of the Bureau, at its meeting on 10 April, that the request for urgent procedure should be agreed to.

The Assembly agreed to the request.

The Assembly agreed that the matter should be referred to the Committee on Equal Opportunities for Women and Men for report (*Reference No. 3207*).

There had been a second request for an urgent debate, in accordance with Rule 50 of the Rules of Procedure, on Cheated Presidential elections of 19 March 2006 and the aftermath in Belarus.

The President informed the Assembly of the recommendation of the Bureau, at its meetings on 16 March and 10 April, that the request for urgent procedure should be agreed to.

The Assembly agreed to the request.

The Assembly agreed that the matter should be referred to the Political Affairs Committee for report with the title amended to Belarus in the aftermath of the Presidential election of 19 March 2006 (*Reference No. 3208*).

8. ADOPTION OF THE ORDER OF BUSINESS FOR THE SECOND PART OF THE 2006 ORDINARY SESSION

The President, on behalf of the Bureau, proposed the adoption of the draft order of business for the part session as drawn up by the Bureau at its meeting on 16 March and that morning.

The draft order of business was agreed to.

On the proposal of the President, the Assembly agreed that there would be a limit on speeches of 4 minutes during the debates that afternoon, on Tuesday afternoon and all day on Thursday, and limits of 4 minutes for chairpersons of political groups and of 3 minutes for other Members on Tuesday morning.

9. ADOPTION OF THE MINUTES OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE

The Assembly took note of the Minutes of the meeting of the Standing Committee in Paris on 17 March 2006.

10. ORGANISATION OF DEBATES

On the proposal of the President the Assembly agreed that the list of speakers in the debate on the Progress Report of the Bureau of the Assembly and the Standing Committee be interrupted at about 4.25 p.m., the list of speakers in the debate on "The place of mother tongue in school education" at about 5.40 p.m. and the list of speakers in the debate on "Poverty and the fight against corruption in the Council of Europe member states" be interrupted at 6.55 p.m.

11. PROGRESS REPORT OF THE BUREAU AND THE STANDING COMMITTEE

The Progress Report of the Bureau of the Assembly and Standing Committee (Doc. 10874) was presented by Mr Igor Ivanovski, Rapporteur.

The observation of the parliamentary elections in Ukraine on 26 March 2006 (Doc. 10878) was presented by Mrs Renate Wohlwend, Rapporteur.

The President welcomed Mr Thomas Hammarberg, Council of Europe Commissioner for Human Rights.

Mr Hammarberg addressed the Assembly.

The President thanked Mr Hammarberg.

The debate was opened.

Speakers: Mrs Minodora Cliveti, Mr Luc Van den Brande, Mrs Hanne Severinsen, Mr Mikhail Margelov, Mrs Sinikka Hurskainen, Mr Holger Haibach and Mr Tadeusz Iwiński.

Speaker (on a point of order): Mr Robert Walter

Speakers: Mr Michael Hancock, Mr Murat Mercan and Mr Konstantin Kosachev.

Mr Bernard Schreiner, a Vice-President of the Assembly, took the Chair in place of Mr René van der Linden.

Speaker: Mr Wolfgang Wodarg.

The list of speakers was interrupted.

The text of the remaining speeches could be printed with the Official Report.

Mr Ivanovski, Rapporteur of the Bureau of the Assembly and the Standing Committee, replied to the debate.

The debate was closed.

The Assembly approved the Progress Report of the Bureau of the Assembly and the Standing Committee (Doc. 10874).

12. THE PLACE OF MOTHER TONGUE IN SCHOOL EDUCATION

The Report of the Committee on Culture, Science and Education on The place of mother tongue in school education (Doc. 10837) was presented by Mr Jacques Legendre, Rapporteur.

The debate was opened.

Speakers: Mr Axel Fischer, Mr Morten Østergaard, Mr Morten Messerschmidt, M. Lluís Maria de Puig, Mrs Majléne Westerlund Panke, M. Philippe Nachbar, Mrs Elmira Akhundova.

Mr Legendre, Rapporteur of the Committee on Culture, Science and Education, replied to the debate.

The debate was closed.

The Assembly considered the draft recommendation contained in Doc. 10837.

The President announced that the amendments to the draft recommendation would be taken in the following order: Nos. 2 to 4, 1, 5, 6, 8, 7.

An amendment (No. 2) was proposed by Mr Boriss Cilevičs, Mrs Carina Ohlsson, Mr Bill Etherington, Mrs Majléne Westerlund Panke, Mr Ed van Thijn, in the draft recommendation, paragraph 1, second sentence, replace the words "a national" with the following words: "an ethnic".

Speakers: Mr Boriss Cilevičs, Mr Legendre.

An oral sub-amendment was proposed by Mr Legendre, on behalf of the Committee on Culture, Science and Education, to replace the words "an ethnic" with the words "a cultural".

The President declared that the oral sub-amendment met the criteria of Rule 34.6.

Speaker: Mr Boriss Cilevičs

The sub-amendment was agreed to.

Since the sub-amendment was agreed to, the amendment fell.

Another amendment (No. 3) was proposed by Mr Boriss Cilevičs, Mrs Carina Ohlsson, Mr Bill Etherington, Mrs Majléne Westerlund Panke, Mr Ed van Thijn, Mr Wolfgang Wodarg, Mrs Angelika Graf, in the draft recommendation, at the end of paragraph 2, add the following sentence:

"Recommendation 1255 (1995) on the protection of the rights of national minorities, Recommendation 1285 (1996) on the protection of the rights of national minorities, Recommendation 1300 (1995) on the protection of the rights of minorities, Recommendation 1345 (1997) on the protection of national minorities, Recommendation 1492 (2001) on rights of national minorities, and Recommendation 1623 (2003) on rights of national minorities are also relevant."

Speakers: Mr Boriss Cilevičs, Mr Legendre

The amendment was not agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 4) was proposed by Mr Boriss Cilevičs, Mrs Carina Ohlsson, Mr Bill Etherington, Mrs Majléne Westerlund Panke, Mr Ed van Thijn, Mr Wolfgang Wodarg, Mrs Angelika Graf, in the draft recommendation, paragraph 3, after the word "languages", insert the following words: "and the Framework Convention for the Protection of National Minorities".

Speakers: Mr Boriss Cilevičs, Mr Legendre.

The amendment was not agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 1) was proposed by Mr Axel Fischer, Mr Ingo Schmitt, Mr Johannes Pflug, Mr Detlef Dzembritzki, Mrs Veronika Bellmann, Mr Hubert Deittert, Mr Eduard Lintner, in the draft recommendation, paragraph 12.3.3, replace the word "possible" with the words: "appropriate and useful".

Speakers: Mr Axel Fischer, Mr Legendre.

The amendment was agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 5) was proposed by Mr Boriss Cilevičs, Mrs Carina Ohlsson, Mr Bill Etherington, Mrs Majléne Westerlund Panke, Mr Ed van Thijn, in the draft recommendation, paragraph 12.3.4, replace the words "languages with parents and communities so that their commitment to a threatened" with the following words: ", minority and regional languages with parents and communities so that their commitment to this".

Speakers: Mr Boriss Cilevičs, Mr Legendre.

The amendment was not agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 6) was proposed by Mr Boriss Cilevičs, Mrs Carina Ohlsson, Mr Bill Etherington, Mrs Majléne Westerlund Panke, Mr Ed van Thijn, Mr Wolfgang Wodarg, Mrs Angelika Graf, in the draft recommendation, after paragraph 12.3.4, add the following sub-paragraph: "develop and implement policies for the use of languages in education, in open dialogue and permanent consultation with the concerned linguistic minority groups;".

Speakers: Mr Boriss Cilevičs, Mr Legendre.

An oral sub-amendment was proposed by Mr Legendre, to delete the word "minority".

The President declared that the oral sub-amendment met the criteria of Rule 34.6.

The sub-amendment was agreed to.

The amendment, as amended, was agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 8) was proposed by Mr Julio Padilla, Mrs Blanca Fernández-Capel, Mr Gabino Puche, Mr Pedro Agramunt, Mr Miguel Arias, in the draft recommendation, after paragraph 12.3.4, add the following sub-paragraph:

"also protect the official language of the state, as a mother tongue, in regions where another official language already exists;".

Speakers: Mr Julio Padilla, Mr Legendre.

The amendment was not agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 7) was proposed by Mr Boriss Cilevičs, Mrs Carina Ohlsson, Mr Bill Etherington, Mrs Majléne Westerlund Panke, Mr Ed van Thijn, Mr Wolfgang Wodarg, Mrs Angelika Graf, in the draft recommendation, at the end of paragraph 12.4, add the following words: "in particular, the European Charter for Regional or Minority Languages and the Framework Convention for the Protection of National Minorities".

Speakers: Mr Boriss Cilevičs, Mr Legendre.

The amendment was not agreed to.

The Assembly agreed to the draft recommendation contained in Doc. 10837, as amended (*Recommendation 1472 (2006)*).

Mr Jean-Charles Gardetto, a Vice-President of the Assembly, took the Chair in place of Mr Schreiner.

13. POVERTY AND THE FIGHT AGAINST CORRUPTION IN THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE MEMBER STATES

The Report of the Social, Health and Family Affairs Committee on Poverty and the fight against corruption in the Council of Europe member states (Doc. 10834 and Addendum) was presented by Mr Alain Cousin, Rapporteur.

The debate was opened.

Speakers: Mr Stepan Demirchyan, Mr David Wilshire, Mr Anatoliy Rakhansky, Mr Jaume Bartumeu Cassany, Mr Holger Haibach, Mrs Josette Durrieu, M. Jean-Guy Branger, M. Armen Rustamyan, Ms Gultakin Hajiyeva.

Mr Cousin, Rapporteur of the Social, Health and Family Affairs Committee, and Mr Abdülkadir Ateş, Chairman of the Social, Health and Family Affairs Committee, replied to the debate.

The list of speakers was interrupted.

The debate was closed.

The Assembly agreed to the draft resolution contained in Doc. 10834 (*Resolution 1472 (2006)*).
