MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS

Mr Giuseppe Arzilli, a Vice-President of the Assembly, took the Chair at 3.05 p.m.

1. MINUTES

The minutes of the ninth sitting were agreed to.

2. ATTENDANCE REGISTER

The names of the Representatives, Substitutes and Observers who signed the attendance register are given in the Appendix.

3. ELECTION OF A JUDGE TO THE EUROPEAN COURT OF HUMAN RIGHTS IN RESPECT OF LIECHTENSTEIN

The result of voting in the election of a judge to the European Court of Human Rights in respect of Liechtenstein was declared as follows:

The Vice-President announced that Mr Villiger, having obtained an absolute majority of votes cast, was elected a member of the European Court of Human Rights for a term of office starting 31 August 2006 and continuing until 31 August 2012.

The oral opinion of the Committee on Legal Affairs and Human Rights was presented by Mr Adrian Severin, Rapporteur.

The debate was opened.

Mr Murat Mercan, a Vice-President of the Assembly, took the chair in place of Mr René van der Linden.

Speakers: Mr Tigran Torosyan, Mr Konstantinos Vrettos, Mr Artashes Geghamyan, Mr Jean-Pierre Kucheida, Mr Rudy Salles, Mr Per-Kristian Foss, Mrs Ruth-Gaby Vermot-Mangold, Baroness Gloria Hooper, Mr Joachim Hörster, Mr Alexander Fomenko, Mr Michael Eitan, Mr İbrahim Özal, Mrs María Rosario Fátima Aburto, Mr Andrea Rigoni, Mr Emanuelis Zingeris.

Mr Margelov, Rapporteur of the Political Affairs Committee, Mr Severin, Rapporteur of the Committee on Legal Affairs and Human Rights, and Mr Abdülkadir Ateş, Chairman of the Political Affairs Committee, replied to the debate.

The debate was closed.

The Assembly considered the draft resolution contained in Doc. 10882.

The President announced that the amendments to the draft resolution would be taken in the following order: Nos 2, 1 and 3.

An amendment (No. 2) was proposed by Mr Emanuelis Zingeris, Mr Tadeusz Iwiński, Mr Zbigniew Rau, Mrs Janina Fetlińska, Mr Tadeusz Wita, Mr Krzysztof Bosak, Mr Miroslav Beneš, Mr Tomáš Jirsa, in the draft resolution, after paragraph 2, insert the following paragraph:

"However, the Assembly notes that democracy does not end with elections. Democracy has never been merely a procedural process such as holding elections, but represents a complex of substantive values that include basic principles promoted by the Council of Europe such as peace, tolerance, the sanctity of human life, the negation of violence as a political tool, and respect for the rule of law."

The amendment was agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 1) was proposed by Mr Ignacio Cosidó, Mr Miguel Barceló Pérez, Mr Adolfo Fernández Aguilar, Mr Gabino Puche, Mr Miguel Arias, Mr Joan Albert Farré Santuré, in the draft resolution, replace paragraph 15 with the following paragraph:

"Nonetheless, the Assembly maintains that the application of Assembly Resolution 1245 (2001) should be conditional on fulfillment of the actions set out in paragraph 10 of the present Resolution."

The amendment was not agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 3) was proposed by Mrs María Rosario Fátima Aburto, Mr Joan Puig Cordón, Mr Lluís Maria de Puig, Mrs Meritxell Batet, Mr Ramón Jáuregui, in the draft resolution, after paragraph 16, add the following paragraph:

"The Assembly believes that the Committee of Ministers should reaffirm its commitment to the establishment of negotiations of the peace process with all possible diplomatic and political efforts."

Speakers: Mrs María Rosario Fátima Aburto, Mr Abdülkadir Ateş.

The amendment was agreed to.

The Assembly agreed the draft resolution contained in Doc. 10882, as amended, (Resolution 1493 (2006)).

6. SOCIAL REINTEGRATION OF PRISONERS

The Report of the Social, Health and Family Affairs Committee on The social reintegration of prisoners (Doc. 10838) was presented Mr Ali Riza Gülçiçek, Rapporteur.

The oral opinion of the Committee on Legal Affairs and Human Rights was presented by Mr Michel Hunault, Rapporteur.

The debate was opened.

Speakers: Mr Piotr Wach, Mr Bernard Marguet.

Mr Cezar Florin Preda, a Vice-President of the Assembly, took the Chair in place of Mr Murat Mercan.

Speakers: Mr Humfrey Malins, Mr Ioannis Bougas, Mrs Sinikka Hurskainen, Mrs Gülsün Bilgehan, Mr Valery Grebennikov, Mr Valery Fedorov.

Mr Ali Riza Gülçiçek, Rapporteur of the Social, Health and Family Affairs Committee, Mr Michel Hunault, Rapporteur of the Committee on Legal Affairs and Human Rights, and Mr Marcel Glesener, Chairperson of the Social, Health and Family Affairs Committee, replied to the debate.

The debate was closed.

The Assembly considered the draft recommendation contained in Doc. 10838.

The President announced that the amendments to the draft recommendation would be taken in the following order: Nos 1 to 4, 8, 5, 7 and 6.

The amendment was agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 2) was proposed by Mr Humfrey Malins, Mr Nigel Evans, Mr David Wilshire, Mr John Greenway, Mr Robert Walter, in the draft recommendation, paragraph 3, replace the word "five" with the following word: "two".

The amendment was withdrawn.

The amendment was agreed to.

An oral amendment was proposed by Mr Marcel Glesener, on behalf of the Social, Health and Family Affairs Committee, after "Assembly" insert "noting the high level of illiteracy amongst prisoners".

The President declared that the oral amendment met the criteria of Rule 34.6.

Speaker: Mr Ali Riza Gülçiçek.

The oral amendment was agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 4) was proposed by Mr Humfrey Malins, Mr Nigel Evans, Mr David Wilshire, Mr John Greenway, Mr Robert Walter, in the draft recommendation, paragraph 7, after the word "Assembly", insert the following words: ", noting that many prisoners can neither read nor write,".

Since the oral amendment was agreed to, amendment (No. 4) fell.

Another amendment (No. 8) was proposed by Mr Humfrey Malins, Mr Nigel Evans, Mr David Wilshire, Mr John Greenway, Mr Robert Walter, in the draft recommendation, at the end of paragraph 7, add the following words: "for up to 25 hours per week".

The amendment was agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 5) was proposed by Mr Humfrey Malins, Mr Nigel Evans, Mr David Wilshire, Mr John Greenway, Mr Robert Walter, in the draft recommendation, at the end of paragraph 7, add the following words: "Further, recognising that sport, particularly team sport, can help divert young people from crime, the Assembly believes that sporting activities should be more widely available in all prisons".

The amendment was agreed to.

An oral sub-amendment was proposed by Mr Marcel Glesener, on behalf of the Social, Health and Family Affairs Committee, after "encourage" insert "and enable".

The President declared that the oral sub-amendment met the criteria of Rule 34.6.

The oral sub-amendment was agreed to.

"the particular needs of long-term prisoners."
