Motion for a resolution presented by Mr Gross and others

This motion has not been discussed in the Assembly and commits only the members who have signed it

- 1. The Assembly recalls that on 4 November 1999 its Rules of Procedure were completely revised (Resolution 1202 (1999)). The new Rules entered into force on 24 January 2000.
- 2. The Assembly considers that the time has come to review the new or amended provisions. Furthermore, those provisions which in Assembly or Standing Committee practice have not given complete satisfaction or have given rise to difficulties, should be adjusted.
- 3. At the same time other suggestions which will be made in the course of the review, should also be taken into account.
- The Assembly therefore decides to proceed with this review with a view to a report containing precise proposals.
