#### **MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS**

Mr van der Linden, President of the Assembly, took the Chair at 3 p.m.

#### 1. ATTENDANCE REGISTER

The names of the Representatives, Substitutes and Observers who signed the attendance register are given in the Appendix.

#### 2. ELECTION OF THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE COMMISSIONER FOR HUMAN RIGHTS

The result of voting in the second round of the election of the Council of Europe Commissioner for Human Rights, in which a relative majority was required, was declared as follows:

Blank or spoilt ballot papers:	0
Valid votes cast:	230
Mr Hammarberg	104
Mr Nowicki	93
Mr Verwilghen	33

The President declared Mr Hammarberg elected Council of Europe Commissioner for Human Rights for a non-renewable term of office of six years starting on 1 January 2006, and congratulated him on his election.

#### 3. CHANGE TO THE ORDER OF BUSINESS

In light of the number of speakers wishing to participate in the debate on The Council of Europe and the European Neighbourhood Policy of the European Union on the morning of Thursday 6 October, the President proposed that the debate be extended into the afternoon sitting, followed by the votes. The debate under urgent procedure on Europe and bird flu – preventive health measures would begin at about 4 p.m.

The Assembly agreed to the proposal.

#### 4. ORGANISATION OF DEBATES

On the proposal of the President, the Assembly agreed that the list of speakers in the debate on the OECD and the world economy would be interrupted at 5.30 p.m., and the list of speakers in the debate on Forced marriages and child marriages would be interrupted at 6.40 p.m.

# 5. OECD AND THE WORLD ECONOMY (ENLARGED DEBATE)

The Report of the Committee on Economic Affairs and Development (Doc. 10645) was presented by Mr Vrettos, Rapporteur.

The contribution of the Social, Health and Family Affairs Committee (Doc. 10704) was presented by Mr Hancock.

The contribution of the Committee on Migration, Refugees and Population (Doc. 10699)<sup>£</sup> was presented by Mr Braun.

The contribution of the Committee on Culture, Science and Education (Doc. 10702) was presented by Mrs Pericleous Papadopoulos.

The contribution of the Committee on Environment, Agriculture and Local and Regional Affairs (Doc. 10709) was presented by Mr Dupraz.

The President welcomed Mr Donald J Johnston, Secretary-General of the OECD.

Mr Johnston, Secretary-General of the OECD, addressed the Assembly.

The President thanked Mr Johnston.

The debate was opened.

Speakers: MM Sasi, Szalay.

Mrs Papadimitriou, a Vice-President of the Assembly, took the Chair in place of Mr van der Linden.

Speakers: MM Walter, Kox, Elo, Kucheida, Lee (Observer, Canada), Korobeynikov, Wielowieyski, Baroness Hooper.

Mr Johnston, Secretary General of the OECD, replied to the debate.

Speakers: MM Seko (Observer, Japan), Jonas, Högmark.

Mr Schreiner, a Vice-President of the Assembly, took the Chair in place of Mrs Papadimitriou.

Speakers: MM Margáin Berlanga (Observer, Mexico), Pol, Özal, Mrs Lalonde (Observer, Canada), MM Jáuregui, Oliynyk.

The Speakers' list was interrupted at 5.30 p.m.

Mr Vrettos, Rapporteur of the Committee on Economic Affairs and Development, and Mrs Pericleous Papadopoulos, on behalf of the Committee, replied to the debate.

The debate was closed.

The Assembly considered the draft resolution contained in Doc. 10645.

Mr Kox requested leave to present an oral amendment. The President declared that the oral amendment did not meet the criteria of Rule 34.6, and therefore could not be taken into consideration.

The Assembly agreed the draft resolution contained in Doc. 10645 (Resolution 1467 (2005)).

## 6. FORCED MARRIAGES AND CHILD MARRIAGES

The Report of the Committee on Equal Opportunities for Women and Men on Forced Marriages and Child Marriages (Doc. 10590) was presented by Mrs Zapfl-Helbling, Rapporteur.

The opinion of the Social, Health and Family Affairs Committee (Doc. 10678) was presented by Mrs Bargholtz, Rapporteur.

The debate was opened.

Speakers: MM Hancock, Lund, Mrs Rupprecht, Mrs Papadimitriou, Mrs Wurm, MM Branger, Gülçiçek, Eörsi.

The Speakers' list was interrupted at 6.40 p.m.

The text of the remaining speeches could be printed with the official report.

Mrs Zapfl-Helbling, Rapporteur of the Committee on Equal Opportunities for Women and Men, Mrs Bargholtz, on behalf of the Social, Health and Family Affairs Committee, and Mrs Çurdová, Vice-Chairperson of the Committee, replied to the debate.

The debate was closed.

The Assembly considered the draft resolution contained in Doc. 10590.

The President announced that the amendments would be considered in the following order: Nos. 1, 6, 7, 2, 9, 8, 10, 11, 3.

An amendment (No. 1) was proposed by Mrs Helena Bargholtz, on behalf of the Social, Health and Family Affairs Committee. Replace the title of the draft resolution with the following title:

"Forced marriages, including child marriages".

Speakers: Mrs Bargholtz, Mrs Zapfl-Helbling, Mrs Curdová.

The amendment was not agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 6) was proposed by Mr Tony Lloyd, Mr Edward O'Hara, Lord Tomlinson, Mr Paul Flynn, Ms Chris McCafferty, in the draft resolution, delete paragraph 7.

Speakers: Mr Lloyd, Mrs Err, Mrs Çurdová.

The amendment was not agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 7) was proposed by Mr Tony Lloyd, Mr Edward O'Hara, Lord Tomlinson, Mr Paul Flynn, Ms Chris McCafferty, in the draft resolution, at the end of paragraph 7, insert the following words:

", other than in circumstances where persons aged sixteen or seventeen wish to marry and parental consent has been received."

Speakers: Mr Lloyd, Mrs Rupprecht, Mrs Çurdová.

The amendment was not agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 2) was proposed by Mrs Helena Bargholtz, on behalf of the Social, Health and Family Affairs Committee, in the draft resolution, at the end of paragraph 8, add the following sentence:

"Often an obstacle to school attendance, child marriages may be prejudicial to children's access to education and their intellectual and social development, in that they restrict their horizon to the family circle".

Speakers: Mrs Bargholtz, Mrs Çurdová.

The amendment was agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 9) was proposed by Mr Tony Lloyd, Mr Edward O'Hara, Lord Tomlinson, Mr Paul Flynn, Ms Chris McCafferty, in the draft resolution, paragraph 12, delete the words "by making eighteen years the minimum marriageable age. Thus, persons not having reached that age would not be able to lawfully contract marriage."

Speakers: Mr Lloyd, Mrs Zapfl-Helbling, Mrs Çurdová.

The amendment was not agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 8) was proposed by Mr Tony Lloyd, Mr Edward O'Hara, Lord Tomlinson, Mr Paul Flynn, Ms Chris McCafferty, in the draft resolution, replace paragraph 12 with the following paragraph:

"It therefore stresses the need to take the requisite legislative measures to prohibit child marriage by making eighteen years the minimum marriageable age, other than in cases where persons aged sixteen or seventeen wish to marry and have received parental consent. Thus persons not having reached those ages and persons aged sixteen or seventeen who have not received parental consent would not be able to contract marriage legally."

The amendment was not agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 10) was proposed by Mr Tony Lloyd, Mr Edward O'Hara, Lord Tomlinson, Mr Paul Flynn, Ms Chris McCafferty, in the draft resolution, paragraph 14.2.1, replace the words "at or raise to eighteen years the" with the following word:

"a"

Speakers: Mr Lloyd, Mr Eörsi, Mrs Çurdová.

The amendment was not agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 11) was proposed by Mr Tony Lloyd, Mr Edward O'Hara, Lord Tomlinson, Mr Paul Flynn, Ms Chris McCafferty, in the draft resolution, at the end of paragraph 14.2.1, insert the following words:

", except that persons aged sixteen or seventeen shall be legally allowed to marry when parental consent has been given:"

The amendment was withdrawn.

Another amendment (No. 3) was proposed by Mrs Helena Bargholtz, on behalf of the Social, Health and Family Affairs Committee, in the draft resolution, delete paragraph 14.3.

Speakers: Mrs Bargholtz, Mrs Err, Mrs Çurdová.

The amendment was not agreed to.

The Assembly agreed the draft resolution contained in Doc. 10590, as amended (Resolution 1468 (2005)).

The Assembly considered the draft recommendation contained in Doc. 10590.

The President announced that the amendments would be considered in the following order: Nos. 4, 13, 12, 5.

An amendment (No. 4) was proposed by Mrs Helena Bargholtz, on behalf of the Social, Health and Family Affairs Committee. Replace the title of the draft recommendation with the following title:

"Forced marriages, including child marriages".

Speaker. Mrs Bargholtz.

The amendment was withdrawn.

Another amendment (No. 13) was proposed by Mr Tony Lloyd, Mr Edward O'Hara, Lord Tomlinson, Mr Paul Flynn, Ms Chris McCafferty, in the draft recommendation, paragraph 2.1, replace the words "the right to choose one's future partner and the right not to marry before 18 years of age" with the following words:

"and the right to choose one's future partner".

Speaker. Mr Lloyd.

The amendment was not moved.

Another amendment (No. 12) had been tabled by Mr Tony Lloyd, Mr Edward O'Hara, Lord Tomlinson, Mr Paul Flynn, Ms Chris McCafferty, in the draft recommendation, paragraph 2.1, after the words "18 years of age", insert the following words:

"(or at 16 or 17 years of age with parental consent)".

The amendment was not moved.

Another amendment (No. 5) was proposed by Mrs Helena Bargholtz, on behalf of the Social, Health and Family Affairs Committee in the draft recommendation, paragraph 2.3, first line, replace the words "young women and girls" with the following word:

"people".

Speakers: Mrs Bargholtz, Mrs Çurdová.

The amendment was agreed to.

The Assembly agreed the draft recommendation contained in Doc. 10590, as amended (Recommendation 1723 (2005)).
