MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS

Mr Miguel Barceló Pérez, the oldest member present, took the Chair at 3.04 p.m.

1. OPENING OF THE SESSION

The provisional President declared open the 2006 Ordinary Session of the Parliamentary Assembly.

2. EXAMINATION OF CREDENTIALS

The provisional President presented the credentials of new Representatives and Substitutes (Doc. 10787).

Mr Andreas Gross, supported by at least nine other Representatives and Substitutes from at least four other national delegations, objected to the credentials of the delegation of Azerbaijan, under Rule 8 of the Rules of Procedure.

Speakers (on a point of order): Mr Mátyás Eörsi, Mr Samad Seyidov

On the proposal of the provisional President, the Assembly agreed that the credentials of the delegation of Azerbaijan be referred to the Monitoring Committee for report and the Committee on Rules of Procedure and Immunities for opinion (*Reference No. 3170*).

The remaining credentials contained in Doc. 10787 were ratified.

3. ELECTION OF PRESIDENT

The provisional President informed the Assembly that he had received the name of only one candidate for the office of President, namely Mr René van der Linden.

In accordance with Rule 13(3) of the Rules of Procedure, the provisional President declared Mr René van der Linden elected as President of the Assembly.

Mr René van der Linden took the Chair as President of the Assembly.

4. ELECTION OF VICE-PRESIDENTS OF THE ASSEMBLY

The President announced that he had received the nominations of Mr Boris Oliynyk (Ukraine); Mr Erik Jurgens (Netherlands); Mr Bernard Schreiner (France); Mr José Vera Jardim (Portugal); Mr Claudio Azzolini (Italy); Mr Giuseppe Arzilli (San Marino); Mrs Elsa Papadimitriou (Greece); Mr Joachim Hörster (Germany); Mrs María Rosario Fátima Aburto (Spain); Mrs Darja Lavtižar-Bebler (Slovenia); Mr Tony Lloyd (United Kingdom); Mrs Maria Postoico (Moldova); Mr Per-Kristian Foss (Norway); Mr Zoltán Szabó (Hungary); Mr Murat Mercan (Turkey); Mr Cezar Florin Preda (Romania); Mr Jean-Charles Gardetto (Monaco); Mr Konstantin Kosachev (Russian Federation); Mr Igor Ivanovski ("The Former Yugoslav Republic Of Macedonia")

There being no objection, they were duly elected, in accordance with Rule 14(4) of the Rules of Procedure. The Vice-Presidency in respect of Georgia remained vacant.

5. APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF COMMITTEES

The Assembly ratified the appointment of members of committees as set out in document Commissions (2006)1 and Addendum.

6. REQUESTS FOR URGENT PROCEDURE DEBATES

There had been a request for an urgent debate, in accordance with Rule 50 of the Rules of Procedure, on Freedom of the media in Russia.

The President informed the Assembly of the recommendation of the Bureau, at its meeting on 9 January, that the request for urgent procedure should not be agreed to.

The Assembly did not agree to the request.

There had been a second request for an urgent debate, in accordance with Rule 50 of the Rules of Procedure, on Alleged secret detentions in Council of Europe member states.

The President informed the Assembly of the recommendation of the Bureau, at its meeting on 9 January, that the request for urgent procedure should not be agreed to, but that the topic should be taken as a current affairs debate.

The Assembly agreed to the Bureau's proposal.

There had been a third request for an urgent debate, in accordance with Rule 50 of the Rules of Procedure, on Riots in European cities: lessons and Council of Europe response.

The President informed the Assembly of the recommendation of the Bureau at its meeting on 9 January that the request for urgent procedure should not be agreed to.

The Assembly did not agree to the request.

There had been a fourth request for an urgent debate, in accordance with Rule 50 of the Rules of Procedure, on the Current situation in Belarus.

The President informed the Assembly of the recommendation of the Bureau at its meeting on 9 January that the request for urgent procedure should be agreed to.

The Assembly agreed to the request.

The Assembly agreed that the matter should be referred to the Political Affairs Committee for report and the Committee on Legal Affairs and Human Rights and the Committee on Culture, Science and Education for opinions (*Reference No. 3169*).

There had been a fifth request for an urgent debate, in accordance with Rule 50 of the Rules of Procedure, on the Peril of using energy supply as an instrument of political pressure.

The President informed the Assembly of the recommendation of the Bureau at its meeting on 23 January that the request for urgent procedure should not be agreed to.

Speakers: Mr Mátyás Eörsi, Mr Luc Van den Brande, Mr Abdülkadir Ateş

The Assembly did not agree to the request.

7. ADOPTION OF THE ORDER OF BUSINESS FOR THE FIRST PART OF THE 2006 ORDINARY SESSION

The President, on behalf of the Bureau, proposed the adoption of the draft Order of Business for the part-session, as drawn up by the Bureau on 9 and 23 January with the following amendment proposed by the Bureau.

The debate on the Report of the Monitoring Committee on the contested credentials of the delegation of Azerbaijan would be held on the afternoon of Wednesday 25 January at 3.30 p.m.

The draft order of business, as amended, was agreed to.

On the proposal of the President, the Assembly agreed that there would be a limit of speeches of 4 minutes during the debates all day on Wednesday.

8. ADOPTION OF THE MINUTES OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE

The Assembly took note of the Minutes of the meeting of the Standing Committee in Bucharest on 25 November 2005.

9. ORGANISATION OF DEBATES

On the proposal of the President the Assembly agreed that the list of speakers in the debate on the Progress Report of the Bureau of the Assembly and the Standing Committee be interrupted at about 4.55 p.m. to hear the communication from Mr Terry Davis, and that the debate on the parliamentary dimension of the United Nations should begin at about 6.00 p.m. and be interrupted at about 7.20 p.m..

10. PROGRESS REPORT OF THE BUREAU AND THE STANDING COMMITTEE

The Progress Report of the Bureau of the Assembly and Standing Committee (Doc. 10794 parts 1, 2 and 3) was presented by Mr Bernard Schreiner, Rapporteur.

Mr Bruno Haller, Secretary General of the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe, addressed the Assembly.

The President thanked Mr Haller.

Mr Tony Lloyd, a Vice-President of the Assembly, took the Chair in place of Mr René van der Linden.

The observation of the referendum on constitutional reforms in Armenia of 27 November 2005 (Doc. 10778) was presented by Mr Nigel Evans, on behalf of Mr Tomáš Jirsa, Rapporteur, and the observation of the presidential election in Kazakhstan of 4 December 2005 (Doc. 10789) was presented by Mr Tadeusz Iwiński, Rapporteur.

The debate was opened.

Mr Bernard Schreiner, Rapporteur of the Bureau of the Assembly and the Standing Committee, and Mr Nigel Evans, replied to the debate.

Mr René van der Linden, President of the Assembly, took the Chair in place of Mr Terry Lloyd.

Mr Davis addressed the Assembly and answered questions from Mr Theodorus Pangalos, Mr Michel Hunault and Mr Mehmet Tekelioğlu.

The President thanked Mr Davis.

12. PARLIAMENTARY DIMENSION OF THE UNITED NATIONS

The Report of the Political Affairs Committee on the Parliamentary Dimension of the United Nations (Doc. 10771) was presented by Mrs Tana de Zulueta, Rapporteur.

The President welcomed Mr Jan Eliasson, President of the United Nations General Assembly.

Mr Eliasson addressed the Assembly.

The President thanked Mr Eliasson.

The debate was opened.

Speakers: MM Morton Østergaard, Anatoliy Korobeynikov, Anatoliy Rakhansky, Mrs Lydie Err, MM Sead Avdić, Jean-Marie Geveaux, Andreas Gross, Per—Kristian Foss, Mrs Rodica Mihaela Stănoiu, Mrs Elsa Papadimitriou, Baroness Hooper, Mrs Lorna Milne.

Mr Jan Eliasson, President of the United Nations General Assembly, Mrs Tana de Zulueta, Rapporteur of the Political Affairs Committee and Mr Abdülkadir Ateş, Chairman of the Political Affairs Committee replied to the debate.

The debate was closed.

The Assembly considered the draft Resolution contained in Doc. 10771.

An amendment (No. 1) was proposed by Mr Anatoliy Rakhansky, Mr Vitaliy Shybko, Mr Orest Klympush, Mr Volodymyr Rybak, Mr Mykhailo Hladiy, Mr Bohdan Kostynuk, Mrs Kseniya Lyapina, Mrs Olena Bondarenko in the draft resolution, paragraph 5, after the words "This process should begin", to insert the following words: "through the setting up within national parliaments of groups of members of parliament to support co-operation with the United Nations".

Speaker: Mr Anatoliy Rakhansky.

The amendment was agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 2) was proposed by Mr Anatoliy Rakhansky, Mr Vitaliy Shybko, Mr Orest Klympush, Mr Volodymyr Rybak, Mr Mykhailo Hladiy, Mr Bohdan Kostynuk, Mrs Kseniya Lyapina, Mrs Olena Bondarenko, in the draft resolution, after paragraph 11, 1, 1, 3, to insert the following subparagraph "setting up with the United Nations and its institutions of national information and research centres for parliamentarians, local government representatives, representatives of NGOs and volunteers in member states;".

Speaker: Mr Anatoliy Rakhansky.

The amendment was agreed to.

The Assembly agreed to the draft Resolution contained in Doc. 10771, as amended (Resolution 1476 (2006)).
