Nutrigenomics and Health | From Vision to Food LMC International Food Congress 2006

The congress will include: Plenary sessions, parallel sessions and a poster session.

The **plenary sessions** will comprise lectures given by internationally respected scientists who have been invited to present current and future research and ideas within areas such as nutrigenomics and the obesity problem, bioinformatics, the industry's expectations to nutrigenomics in relation to consumer health, system biology in Chinese nutrition and medicine, visions for nutrigenomics, and pertinent ethical aspects.

The **parallel sessions** will be comprised of in-depth lectures by international experts within current topics of nutrigenomics. Each session will be opened by an invited scientist of high international status.

The focus in sessions 3 and 6 will primarily be applied research. Sessions 1, 2, 4 and 5 will focus predominantly on basic research.

The short lectures will be based on selected submitted abstracts received before November 30, 2005. The abstracts and short papers received from the keynote speakers will be published as a supplement to the *Scandinavian Journal of Food & Nutrition*, March 2006.

To complementing the plenary and parallel sessions a **poster session** entitled *Food and Health* will give a larger number of scientists the opportunity to present their data, giving the congress delegates further opportunity to learn about and explore the many aspects of nutrigenomics.
