1. MINUTES

5. HONOURING OF OBLIGATIONS AND COMMITMENTS BY MONACO (DOC. 11299)

The report of the Committee on the Honouring of Obligations and Commitments by Member States of the Council of Europe (Monitoring Committee) (Doc. 11299) was presented by Mr Pedro Agramunt and Mr Leonid Slutsky, Co-Rapporteurs.

The debate was opened.

Mr Pedro Agramunt and Mr Leonid Slutsky, Co-Rapporteurs, and Mr Eduard Lintner, Chairman, Committee on the Honouring of Obligations and Commitments by Member States of the Council of Europe (Monitoring Committee), replied to the debate.

The debate was closed.

The Assembly proceeded to consider the draft resolution contained in Doc. 11299.

An amendment (No. 1) was proposed by Mr Erik Jurgens, Mr Abdülkadir Ateş, Mr Andreas Gross, Mr Pieter Omtzigt, Mrs Corien W A Jonker, Mrs Hanne Severinsen, Mr Christos Pourgourides, Mr Leo Platvoet, Mr Boriss Cilevičs, in the draft resolution, after paragraph 19.1, insert the following subparagraph:

"put an end to princely practice of providing for criminal offences and penalties by Sovereign Orders without consulting the Parliament;"

The amendment was not agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 2) was proposed by Mr Erik Jurgens, Mr Abdülkadir Ateş, Mr Andreas Gross, Mr Pieter Omtzigt, Mrs Corien W A Jonker, Mrs Hanne Severinsen, Mr Christos Pourgourides, Mr Leo Platvoet, Mr Boriss Cilevičs, in the draft resolution, after paragraph 19.1, insert the following subparagraph:

"demarcate more clearly the cases in which the Prince can issue Sovereign Orders, particularly with regard to incorporating international conventions into domestic law;".

The amendment was not agreed to.

Another amendment (No. 3) was proposed by Mr Erik Jurgens, Mr Abdülkadir Ateş, Mr Andreas Gross, Mr Pieter Omtzigt, Mrs Corien W A Jonker, Mrs Hanne Severinsen, Mr Christos Pourgourides, Mr Leo Platvoet, Mr Boriss Cilevičs, in the draft resolution, after paragraph 19.2, insert the following paragraph:

"In order to assist the Monegasque authorities in future reforms, the Assembly decides to request an opinion of the Venice Commission on the Constitution and constitutional practice of the Principality of Monaco".

The amendment was not agreed to.

Mr Leonid Slutsky spoke on a point of order.

The Assembly agreed the draft resolution (Resolution 1566) with 36 votes in favour, 9 votes against and 4 abstentions.
