# **DRAFT RESOLUTION**

## New Challenges to Parliamentary Oversight of the Security Sector

#### The OSCE Parliamentary Assembly:

- 1. <u>Welcoming</u> the significant contribution of the OSCE Code of Conduct on politicomilitary aspects of security to the reform of the security sectors in the OSCE participating States,
- 2. <u>Noting</u> the change in the security environment and the emergence of new threats,
- 3. <u>Acknowledging</u> the security needs of participating States and the right to react while complying to international commitments,
- 4. <u>Recognizing</u> the growing importance of Private Military Companies (PMCs) or Private Security Companies (PSCs) in the implementation of the defence, development, and security agendas,
- 5. <u>Referring</u> to the limited provisions of the Code of Conduct with regard to the democratic control of armed forces,
- 6. <u>Noting</u> the absence of international norms or agreed guidelines regulating activities of PMCs and PSCs,
- 7. <u>Expressing</u> concern about the lack of parliamentary oversight regarding PMCs and PSCs, which counters the principles of the Code of Conduct on democratic control of forces<sup>1</sup> and limit the most legitimate role of parliaments,
- 8. <u>Recognizing</u> international developments with regard to international law, in particular international humanitarian law (IHL) and human rights law (HRL),
- 9. <u>Being aware</u> of the precarious situation of different legal settings for armed forces and PMCs/PSCs operating in situations of armed conflict and post-conflict situations,
- 10. <u>Regretting</u> the absence\_of a detailed discussion on the use of PMCs and PSCs in situations of armed conflict and post-conflict situations,

#### The OSCE Parliamentary Assembly,

11. <u>Calls for</u> a detailed discussion of all relevant actors on the use of PMCs and PSCs in situations of armed conflict and post-conflict situations;

- 12. <u>Requests</u> the SG of the OSCE to initiate a study to the next Winter meeting of the PA in 2009 which should elaborate on the one hand on current use of PMCs and PSCs and on the other hand illustrate best practises in democratic control and use of PMCs and PSCs in situations of armed conflict and post-conflict situations;
- 13. <u>Calls upon</u> participating States with regard to the use of PMCs and PSCs to reaffirm and clarify the existing obligations under international law;
- 14. <u>Urges</u> participating States to extend their parliamentary oversight also to PMCs and PSCs;
- 15. <u>Recommends</u> as a first step the development of a manual on the use PMCs and PSC for missions in armed conflict and post-conflict situations;
- 16. <u>Emphasizes</u> the need for a coordinated and coherent approach with other international actors;
- 17. <u>Calls upon</u> participating States to develop binding rules and procedures on the use of PMCs and PSCs in armed conflict and post-conflict missions.
