Dutch freight transport policy



- Strong position in European logistics: Rotterdam,
 Schiphol International Airport;
- Continuous economic growth --> inevitable growth transport:
- We need all transport modes and all infrastructure to facilitate future growth.

Why EMS?

- Rapid (continuous) growth in road transport;
- Very densely populated country;
- Fast growing large port;
- Ever increasing congestion problem;
- Problems with (local) air quality and emissions (e.g. CO2 emissions);
- Not much other measures available;
- Support by hauliers and shippers (first request for trials 1992!);
