One of the major obstacles to the establishment of a government in Southern Sudan after the signatur of the Comprehensive Peace Agreement was the shortage of qualified staff to fill key positions within the ministries. Hence, UNICEF committed to provide a team of education staff. (one L5, one L3 and one NOB to be seconded to the Ministry of Education. Up to present, UNICEF has only been able to recruit the L5 and the NOB).

Major assignments for the senior advisor post have been:

- The establishment of and set up of a functioning MOEST, included transfer from a Secretariat of Education into a full fledged Ministry of Education, Science and Technology end of 2005.
- Advisory role in development of the Southern Sudan Education Policy (finalized by external consultant).
- Focal point within the MoEST for donor collaboration, recommendation of areas of intervention and identification of funding gaps, prepared input for donor proposals (MDTF, Danida). Serve as the coordinating senior advisor among all the Technical advisors at the office.
- Worked closely with NGOs and prepared education stakeholders meetings and Conferences involving MoEST, Donors, UN, NGOs, Social Society and Community Leaders.
