Mr Chairman,

France will undertake the presidency of the European Union Council on July 1st 2008. On that occasion, the Justice and Home affairs Committees of the Senate and the National Assembly are truly honoured to invite you to participate in the meeting of the Chairpersons of the Justice and Home Affairs Committees of the national parliaments of the EU member states, the candidate countries and the European parliament.


