Dear Chairperson

On 2 October 2008 the Parliamentary Assembly officially launched the "Gender Equality Prize"

This prize will be awarded to political parties which strive to promote gender equality in politics through action that significantly improves women's participation in elected assemblies or political parties, or in their respective executive bodies

All political groups in the national parliaments of the Council of Europe member states may nominate political parties for the prize

Exceptionally, the deadline for submitting candidatures for the first award of the prize has been extended to 1 June 2009. The 2009 prize will be awarded by the President of the Assembly at a ceremony during the Assembly's autumn 2009 session (28 September 2008 - 2 October).
