Dear GLOBE Member,

As President of the Global Legislators Organisation (GLOBE) I write with reference to the letter recently sent to the President/Speaker of your respective Parliament from the President of the Italian Chamber of Deputies, President Gianfranco Fini and the President of the Italian Senate, Senator Renato Giuseppe Schifani. The letter invited your President/Speaker to select a delegation to the forthcoming GLOBE Rome G8+5 Legislators Forum due to convene in the Italian Chamber of Deputies from the 12th-13th June 2009.

This will be the sixth G8+5 Legislators Forum and will convene just ahead of the Italian G8 Summit and the Major Emitters Forum.
