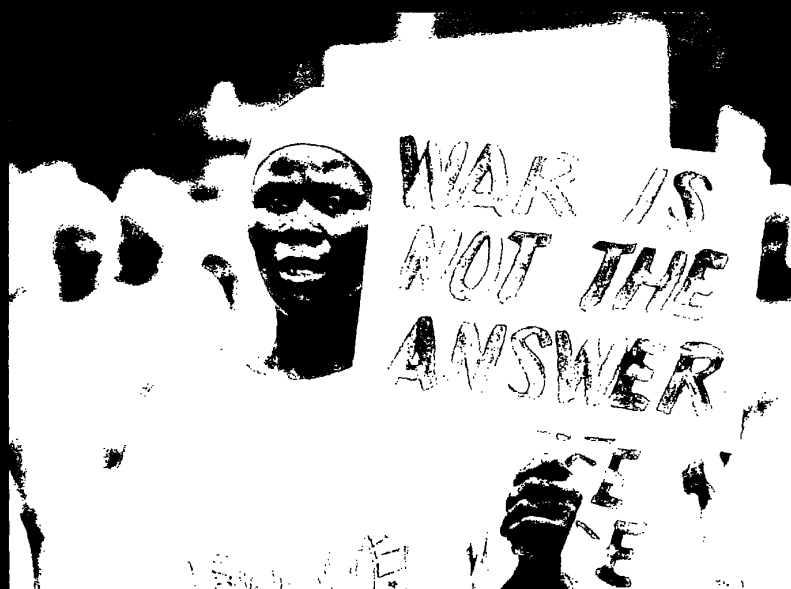

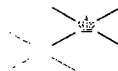
Cover: Front: The Liberian Women Mass Actions for Peace marched through the streets of
