He held various positions of responsibility including Director in the Department for Multilateral Development, Alternate Governor to the African, Asian and Inter-American Development Banks. He represented Sweden at replenishments of the World Bank concessional finance window (IDA).

Stefan has also worked for the United Nations Development Program in Cambodia, the European Commission and most recently at The World Bank. As Advisor to the Vice President of Concessional Finance and Global Partnerships, he was deeply involved in the IDA15 replenishment, and worked on the Bank's trust fund portfolio and innovative financing mechanisms.

He holds an MSc. in International Economics and an MBA both from the Stockholm School of Economics.
