Your Excellency,

I had written to Your Excellency on 14 January 2010, forwarding the resolution passed by the House of Representatives condemning the attacks on the Palestinian Territory of Gaza.

It saddens me once again many civilian lives were lost due to the recent attack by the Zionist Military regime in international waters on the Freedom Flotilla vessel convoy carrying humanitarian aid to Gaza.

The House of Representatives of Malaysia on 7 June 2010 had unanimously passed a resolution **STRONGLY CONDEMNING** the inhumane act which resulted in deaths and injuries to the civilians. This resolution carries the voice and the feelings of the people of Malaysia.

Malaysia stands firm that there is no justification at all for the excessive use of force on the humanitarian aid vessels bound for Gaza in aid of the Palestinian People.

"Palestine will continue being a moral issue", until the International Community to take a more affirmative action, and as keepers of democracy, I pray that this resolution will be able to appeal to the Parliament of all countries, to make every effort to ensure that justice will prevail for the victims of the attack and that the People of Palestine will once again see the light of freedom.

## RESOLUTION ON THE ATTACK BY THE ZIONIST MILITARY REGIME ON THE FREEDOM FLOTILLA - HUMANITARIAN AID MISSION VESSELS TO GAZA PASSED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, MALAYSIA ON 7 JUNE 2010

## THIS HOUSE RESOLVES TO:

- 1) **STRONGLY CONDEMN** the attack by the Zionist Military Regime, under the orders of the Prime Minister of Israel, Benjamin Netanyahu, on the humanitarian aid mission vessels to Gaza which had resulted in deaths and injuries to civilians;
- 2) Record profound **disappointment** with the United Nations Security Council on its mild statement on the violent attack by the Zionist Regime on the humanitarian aid mission vessels
- 3) Decides to **demand** the United Nations Security Council to censure Israel and not merely issuing a mild statement
- 4) Decides for Malaysia to cooperate with the member countries of the Organisation of Islamic Conference (OIC), the Non Aligned Movement (NAM), the Arab League and other like minded countries to uphold the principles of international law, including human rights law, international humanitarian law and the Charter of the United Nations, in dealing with the humanitarian crisis in Gaza;
- 5) Urge like minded countries to propose a motion to the United Nations Security Council to refer the situation resulting from the attack by the Israel Zionist Military Regime to the International Criminal Court (ICC;
- 6) Urge like minded countries to propose a motion to the United Nations General Assembly to seek an Advisory Opinion from the International Court of Justice (ICJ);
- 7) Request the State of Turkey to consider initiating action under the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court (ICC);
- 8) Call for a fully independent investigation to be conducted on the attack by the Zionist Military Regime and not merely an impartial investigation;

- 9) **Fully support** the demands by the international community, particularly the Human Rights Council through its Resolution of 2 June 2010, for an accountable and fully independent investigation to be carried out on the attack;
- 10) Demand Israel not to block any humanitarian aid convoy to the Palestinian People, particularly in Gaza, consistent with the United Nations Security Council Resolution 1860;
- 11) **Welcome** the action by the State of Egypt to unconditionally open the Rafah Border to ensure the unobstructed channeling of humanitarian aid;
- 12) **Appeal** to the international community to continue extending humanitarian aid to the nationals of the Palestinian Territories in Gaza without being intimidated and undaunted by the threats of the Zionist Regime;
- 13) Express **appreciation** to the States of Jordan, Turkey, Ireland, Philippines and other countries that are involved in the efforts to secures the release of Malaysian nationals who were detained by the Zionist Regime;
- 14) Urge the Palestinian People to unite in safeguarding the inalienable right to establish a free, independent and sovereign State of Palestine; and
- 15) **Express the solidarity** of the people of Malaysia towards the cause of the Palestinian People in the establishment of a free, independent and sovereign State of Palestine.
