Dear Prof. van der Maase,  
dear Dr. de Neergaard,

Thank you very much for your letter of 7 July, in which you ask for more detailed information on the treatment of cancer patients that we provide at our university hospital.

Please find my answers to your questions as follows:

Ad 1) According to our experience, which complies with the criteria of different groups in the field of interventional oncology, inclusion of patients for intrahepatic chemotherapy is discussed especially in advanced hepatic involvement of colorectal disease, breast cancer, primary liver cancer like hepatocellular carcinoma, cholangiocarcinoma.

Ad 2) Due to different oncological criteria we have performed several phase-I and phase-II studies for the use of global intrahepatic drugs.

Ad 3) Currently, we perform prospective and retrospective studies for the use of intraarterial chemotherapy. These data are based on the different protocols.

Ad 5) Currently several randomized trials for hepatic metastases are in the planning phase. The Precision V-study for hepatocellular
