Invitation to an inter-parliamentary debate between on Budgets committees on the financing of the Europe 2020 Strategy in the framework of the European Semester

Dear Chair, dear colleague,

As a consequence of the economic crisis, European leaders decided to considerably reinferce the coordination of budgetary policies within the Union. This is the aim of a new procedure, the so called "European Semester", which began on 12 January this year with the presentation of the Annual Growth Survey by the European Commission.

Nevertheless, many practical details of the new procedure remain to be defined. In particular, the exact role of Parliaments has not yet been clearly established. Several national Parliaments have expressed their surprise at this omission and have suggested an exchange of views on the practicalities of parliamentary intervention in an area which is at the heart of their competences.

In this context, the European Parliament's committee on Economic and Monetary Affairs has already organised a first exchange of view with corresponding committees in national parliaments for 15 March next. This meeting will cover the question of economic governance and in particular the new budgetary discipline. An invitation to this meeting has already been addressed to national Parliaments' committees by the committee Chair Sharon Bowles.

On behalf of the committee on Budgets, I now have the honour to invite you to a second exchange of views which will take place on 13 April from 15h00 to 18h30 in the European Parliament in Brussels. This will focus on the other strand of budgetary coordination, i.e. the financing of future policies which are essential to return to growth and in particular those linked to the Europe 2020 Strategy.

As is customary, the present invitation is open to four Members of the competent committees of each parliamentary Assembly (two for each Chamber in case of bicameral parliaments).

The draft programme of the meeting and more detailed practical information for the event will be forwarded to you shortly.
