Kære formand, kære kollega,

Lissabon-traktaten åbner nye muligheder for en dialog mellem Europa-Parlamentet og de nationale parlamenter. I det forløbne år har vi allerede oplevet, at vort partnerskab er blevet styrket gennem en dybere politisk og lovgivningsmæssig dialog om spørgsmål af fælles interesse under de interparlamentariske udvalgsmøder.

For at gøre det endnu nemmere at opretholde mere sammenhængende og effektive forbindelser med de nationale parlamenter har Europa-Parlamentet nu fastlagt en ny procedure for vedtagelse af en omfattende kalender med angivelse af de interparlamentariske aktiviteter, der er berammet til at finde sted i det kommende år, idet der dog skal være tilstrækkelig fleksibilitet i planlægningen, således at der kan tages højde for ændrede behov og ændrede politiske prioriteringer.

Denne kalender vedtages hvert halve år af konferencen af formænd for de politiske grupper, og det er hensigten, at den skal afspejle de forskellige reaktioner fra de nationale parlamenter under konferencen af parlamentsformænd i EU i maj i Stockholm, hvor adskillige understregede behovet for en bedre planlægning.

I overensstemmelse med denne nye procedure glæder det mig at kunne sende Dem kalenderen over de interparlamentariske aktiviteter, der finder sted i Europa-Parlamentet i 2011. På grundlag af oplysninger fra de ungarske og polske rådsformandskaber omfatter mødekalenderen også møder, som de agter at være vært for under deres respektive formandskaber.

Jeg vil også gerne benytte lejligheden til at indbyde repræsentanter for Deres parlament til at deltage i følgende interparlamentariske udvalgsmøder, der afholdes i Europa-Parlamentet i Bruxelles i marts 2011:



Vedlagt fremsendes indbydelsesskrivelserne fra formændene for ovennævnte udvalg, der er vært for de planlagte møder. Jeg skal anmode Dem om at viderebringe disse indbydelser til de(t) relevante udvalg i Deres parlament.

Oplysninger om de møder, der tilrettelægges af de øvrige udvalg i Europa-Parlamentet, fremsendes til sin tid.

Jeg er overbevist om, at kvaliteten af forbindelserne mellem Europa-Parlamentet og de nationale parlamenter og den politiske merværdi, disse forbindelser vil skabe, i sidste ende er resultatet af en fælles indsats. Dette første forsøg på at planlægge vore aktiviteter på en mere hensigtsmæssig måde går i denne retning, og Europa-Parlamentet er fast besluttet på at fortsætte ad denne vej.

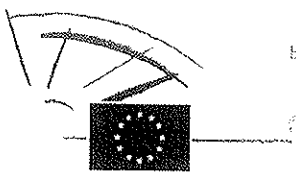

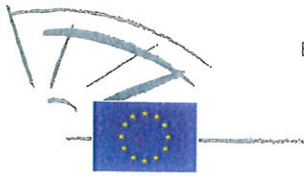

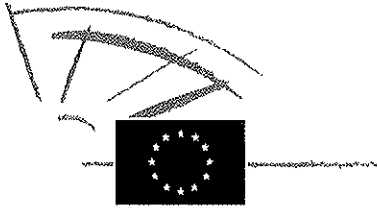

**Subject:**        **Invitation for an interparliamentary meeting on "*Investing in the real economy: A tool kit for growth, innovation and cohesion*"**

The European Parliament's Special Committee on the Financial, Social and Economic Crisis (CRIS), of which I have the honour to be Chairman, proposes to organise an interparliamentary meeting with the National Parliaments on the above-mentioned subject on Monday 14 March 2011 from 15.00 to 18.30 at the European Parliament in Brussels.

This meeting falls within the extension of CRIS' mandate in which it seeks close consultation with National Parliaments. A first part of this consultation was the written consultation through a questionnaire on key policy issues which has already been addressed to you. The forthcoming interparliamentary meeting will debate on issues raised in the questionnaire with a special focus on re-establishing the real economy. The meeting will start with a keynote speaker who will introduce the subject. A panel of National Parliamentarians and MEPs will then debate on the topic.

The meeting will be concluded with a formal dinner event and will host a high level guest speaker. This dinner will be organised jointly with the Economic and Monetary Affairs Committee (ECON) who will hold its interparliamentary meeting the following day (15 March 2011).



The results of the consultations and discussions with National Parliaments will contribute to the CRIS' final report, which will be voted in the European Parliament's plenary in July 2011. It will contain policy recommendations in a ten year perspective on re-establishing the real economy and preventing future financial, economic and social crises.

We are therefore pleased to invite up to four members of the relevant committee(s) of each National Parliament (two from each Chamber of bicameral parliaments) to attend the meeting and dinner.

The practical details regarding the meeting as well as a detailed programme will be forwarded to you in due course via your Parliament's representative for relations with the European Parliament. We have attached a preliminary draft programme which gives an outline of the event.
