The OSCE PA has received an invitation to observe the parliamentary elections in Moldova on 28 November 2010. President Petros Efthymiou has decided to deploy an Election Observation Mission to these elections.

Please find attached a registration form for Members wishing to observe these elections. We kindly ask you to return the completed registration form along with a scanned copy of the Members' passport as well as electronic photograph to the International Secretariat **before 10 November 2010**. Please note that due to observer accreditation procedures, no late registrations will be possible. In addition, I would like to remind you that all observers are expected to arrive in Chisinau in time to attend the briefings on 26-27 November, and stay for the observer debriefing on the morning of 29 November. We are currently working on hotel arrangements and other logistical arrangements, and we will circulate more information as soon as possible.

I also wish to inform you that national parliaments are responsible for all expenses of their members and that all meetings and briefings will be conducted in English only.

The OSCE PA will work in co-operation with the OSCE Office for Democratic Institutions and Human Rights.
