DRAFT RESOLUTION

Women's Representation at the OSCE Parliamentary Assembly

Principal Sponsor: Mr. Jordi Guilloit (Spain)

1. Noting that article 1.4 of the OSCE PA Rules of Procedure states that: “Each national Delegation should have both genders represented”,
2. Noting with concern that in the OSCE PA National Delegations' Members Directory circulated in Vienna on February 21st, 2011, the following appears:
 - a) Out of the 54 national delegations (there is no available data for Uzbekistan or Turkmenistan) in 17 delegations (31.48%) men are the only incumbent,
 - b) 60.27% of the women are deputy members,
 - c) There are only 10 women who are Head of a delegation (18.5%),
 - d) Out of the 307 MPs only 73 (23.7%) are women,
 - e) 26 women MPs (almost 50%) come from 10 delegations,

The OSCE Parliamentary Assembly:

3. Calls on the national parliaments to improve the representation of women in the OSCE PA national delegations in order to go forward in women's empowerment.
