# Memorandum on the OSCE PA Observation of the Parliamentary Elections in Armenia, 6 May 2012

## **Delegation**

The OSCE Parliamentary Assembly has received an official invitation from the President of the National Assembly of the Republic of Armenia, Mr. Samvel Nikoyan, to send a delegation to observe the parliamentary elections in the Republic of Armenia on 6 May 2012. President Petros Efthymiou has decided to send an election observation mission to this election, and he has appointed the Head of the Belgian Delegation to the Assembly, Mr. Francois-Xavier De Donnea, to head the PA Mission. The OSCE PA will co-operate with the long-term observers deployed by the OSCE/ODIHR as well as with the other parliamentary institutions present.

The International Secretariat is currently receiving registrations for the election observation mission to Armenia. Please find attached the registration form which we kindly ask you to complete and return before the **deadline on 16 April 2012** with a copy of each Member's passport.

# **Visas**

Members whose country has an Armenian Diplomatic Representation are requested to apply for and collect their Armenian visas before departure for Yerevan.

#### Airport transfer

We are looking into airport transfer possibilities for the Delegation. We will send you more details about this as soon as possible.

Please also note that there is an exit fee (airport tax) of AMD 10 000 (Approx. EUR 20) which each observer will be required to pay to the airport upon departure from Yerevan in AMD.

#### **Deployment**

On 6 May Members will be deployed to observe the elections in teams of two. Those who have any special wishes concerning the place of their deployment are kindly asked to inform the International Secretariat as soon as possible. **We encourage Members to deploy outside of Yerevan.** 

# Car/driver and interpreter on Election Day

The OSCE/ODIHR will assist us in finding suitable cars/drivers and interpreters for our teams for Election Day. Please let the Secretariat know if your Embassy in Yerevan will provide Members with a car and an interpreter.

The cost for a car/driver on Election Day will be communicated shortly.

I would like to remind you that national parliaments are responsible for their own Member's expenses, including any Hotel cancellations. We also urge Members to have health and travel insurance that is valid in Armenia.
