Maintenance treatment for heroin addiction was originally conceived of as a comprehensive treatment consisting of a combination of medication and psychosocial interventions: focus was on drug counseling and medical, psychiatric and socioeconomic problems.

In the Nordic countries, we have now over 40 years experience of maintenance treatment, with a high variation of treatment protocols, as research findings have been implemented differently in different cultural settings
