**Biografi for Antony Spalton**

Antony has worked for the humanitarian and development sector for more than 20 years. He has worked for NGOs and has spent 16 years with the Red Cross Movement including in Afghanistan, Cambodia, Rwanda and Tanzania. In recent years he managed an IFRC Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) programme focussed on three southern African and four South Asian countries. In 2008, Antony joined UNICEF as a disaster risk reduction specialist. Antony is currently supporting DRR and Climate Change Adaptation work in more than 40 countries. The emphasis of UNICEF's approach is to promote safe and resilient communities for women and children. Ensuring an analysis of disaster risk and subsequent actions to reduce it are part of local, national and UN development plans, promoting the right of children and young people to participate and protecting schools and water resources from hazards are among UNICEF's priorities.
