Background

NATO's Strategic Concept identifies 'cooperative security' as one of NATO's three essential core tasks. It states that the promotion of Euro-Atlantic security is best assured through a wide network of partnerships with countries and organizations across the globe which share NATO's interest in a peaceful world. NATO's new partnership policy is meant to prepare the Alliance for a rapidly changing world where security challenges may come from far afield, and where solutions may require extensive cooperation with other states and organizations which NATO has not traditionally engaged with.

The conference will focus on several key challenges – and perhaps some opportunities – for how NATO may be able to use its new approach to partnerships in a way that can support the continuation of an international order based on dialogue and cooperation across ideological and cultural differences.
