
Where is the green economy?

Prosperity and sustainability "after the crisis"

The University of Copenhagen is pleased to invite you to a Sustainability Lecture with Tim Jackson, Author of the renowned book Prosperity without Growth and Professor of Sustainable Development at University of Surrey.

As the world faces recession, climate change, inequity and more, Tim Jackson challenges the established economic principles and explores a fundamental restructuring of our financial system so that we might stop feeding the crises and start investing in our future.

His book Prosperity without Growth - Economics for a Finite Planet which has been translated into 15 languages, analyses the complex relationships between growth, environmental crises and social recession and investigates to what extend growth does in fact increase human well being.





Tim Jackson is Professor of Sustainable Development at the University of Surrey and Director of the Sustainable Lifestyles Research Group – a multi-disciplinary research group funded by the UK government, which explores the complex links between people's lifestyles, societal values and sustainability.

From 2004 to 2011 Tim Jackson was Economics Commissioner on the UK Sustainable Development Commission, where his work culminated in the publication of the controversial book Prosperity without Growth – economics for a finite planet (Earthscan 2009). In 2013 he was awarded a three year Professorial Fellowship to study Prosperity and Sustainability in the Green Economy (PASSAGE).
