It is a great honor and pleasure to invite you to the 11th General Meeting of the IPCNKR on behalf of the International Parliamentarians' Coalition for North Korean Refugees and Human Rights (IPCNKR).

Members of parliament from around the world have joined and supported the IPCNKR in pursuit of the common objective of promoting and protecting the human rights of North Koreans in compliance with the principles of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.

The IPCNKR has held its annual meetings since its inception in 2003. This year, the 11th General Meeting is scheduled to take place in Bucharest, Romania on 21-23 August 2014.

The Commission of Inquiry on Human Rights in North Korea, set up in March 2013 by the UN Human Rights Council, gathered evidence for almost a year and announced its findings last March. The commission said that there was compelling evidence of torture, execution and arbitrary imprisonment, deliberate starvation, and an almost complete lack of free thought and belief. It concluded that North Korea's leadership is committing systematic and appalling human rights abuses against its own citizens on a scale unparalleled in the modern world, crimes against humanity with strong resemblances to those committed by the Nazis. Taking the findings of the COI into consideration, the General Meeting this year will have as its theme the Role of International Organizations in Resolving the Human Rights Issue in North Korea.

We sincerely hope that you will be able to join us and recommend honorable members of parliament who are interested in human rights issues in Asia to participate in the General Meeting. Please confirm your attendance by **July 18**, **2014**.

We would be pleased to arrange and provide accommodations for two nights during the conference for **up to five** delegates representing each parliament. Please note that the IPCNKR will **not** be able to cover airfare for any invitees.
