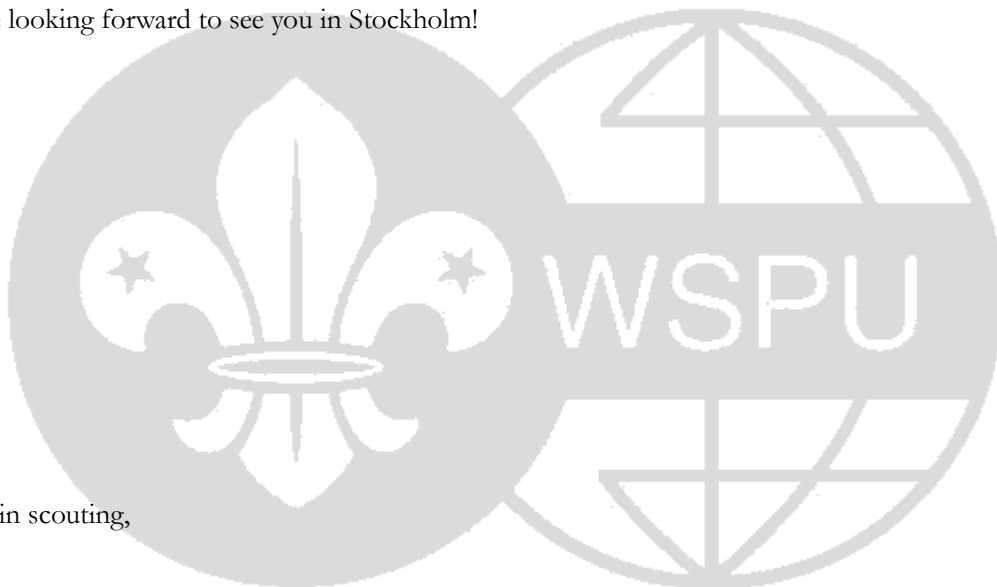
### **Language and interpretation**
