We would like to draw your attention to the next meeting of the **OECD Global Parliamentary Network**, which will take place on **Wednesday 12 October 2016** at the [OECD Conference Centre](#) in Paris. This seminar will be held the day after the Secretary-General's annual address to the [Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe](#) on 11 October in Strasbourg. These two events will be held back-to-back to facilitate parliamentary participation in both meetings.

The meeting will offer an opportunity for parliamentarians to exchange views with their peers and OECD experts on a range of key issues. A dinner will be organised in the evening of 11 October with the participation of the OECD Secretary-General. The meeting on 12 October will cover the following issues: the **Economic Outlook, Digitalisation and the Future of Work, Migration, Gender-sensitive policies, and Responsible Business Conduct**. A draft programme is attached.

We would be grateful if you could share this information with parliamentary representatives from your country, as we would like to attract a high-level of MPs. Staffers are also very welcome to attend.

And, looking further ahead, the **5<sup>th</sup> OECD Parliamentary Days** will take place in **February 2017 (date to be confirmed)** in **Paris**. As always, this will include a meeting of the OECD Global Parliamentary Network, and bilateral meetings with OECD experts. We will provide you with more information closer to the date.
