
As a Global Strategy, it sets out a vision for the role of the European Union on the global scene; it identifies clear priorities in terms of actions to be taken; and it looks at the full spectrum of foreign and security policy instruments at our disposal.

The Global Strategy is the outcome of a wide and open consultation process: all European Institutions and Member States were involved, as well as a number of partners outside our borders. We engaged with the European defence community, security and development experts, students and researchers, think-tanks, civil society organisations.

And the conversation does not end today. This Strategy will be a living document: we need a collective engagement to implement it, and to constantly adapt it to future challenges. This is only the beginning of our work to turn a shared vision into common action.
