Members of parliaments from all around the world have joined and supported IPCNKR for the purpose of promoting and protecting the human rights of North Koreans in compliance with the principles of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. Since its founding in 2003, IPCNKR has held its annual General Meeting. This year, the 14th anniversary General Meeting is scheduled to be held in **Guatemala City**, **Guatemala from the 18th through the 20th of July**, 2017.

On March 24, 2017, the United Nations Human Rights Council (UNHRC) in Geneva has adopted a resolution on the situation of human rights in the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK), widely known as North Korea. The resolution condemns in the strongest terms on North Korea's ongoing crude, systematic, and wide-spread human rights violations, and urges North Korea to take immediate steps to end such violations, including the abductions issue. Taking the finding of the UNHRC resolution into consideration, the General Meeting will have its topic as "The role of international organizations in resolving the issue of North Korean human rights." During the meeting, we would like to open a discussion addressing such issues, and propose ways to make better situation.

We sincerely hope that you will be able to join us and recommend honorable members of parliament who are interested in the issues related to human rights of North Koreans. Please confirm your delegates who will be attending the conference by the date of 5th June, 2017.

We will be delighted to arrange and provide **two nights** of accommodation during the course of conference between **the 18th and 20th of July** for **up to three to maximum of four** delegates representing each parliament. Please note that IPCNKR will <u>not</u> be able to fund the airfare for any invitees.
