I am writing in follow-up to our meeting at the Parliament last week to express our sincere gratitude for the opportunity to provide you and your committee colleagues an overview of our at the country level across a range of climate, disaster and energy initiatives.

UNDP's core mandate, is at the country level. As the UN's main operational development agency, we support governments and other stakeholders in about 170 countries. In this sense, we are different from some of the more specialized agencies of the UN whose work is more focused on the normative, advocacy areas within global discussions.
