41 YEARS OF STRUGGLE FOR INDEPENDENCE, 41 YEARS OF LONG WAIT FOR A FREE SAHARA

Forty-one years of exile are too many. Forty-one years of exile is too much for anyone. Three generations of Sahrawi have grown up in exile or under the illegal Moroccan occupation of their own territories. The Kingdom of Morocco took advantage of the situation of chaos to take control of the Sahrawi territory. This, against the legal essence of the final opinion of the International Court of Justice from The Hague on 10th October 1975.

In a context of social instability, aggravated by the political uncertainty that the delicate medical condition of General Franco created, a late Franco government opted for the easiest solution: the transfer of the territory as an answer to the threat of the Green March. Spain surrendered the territory through the so-called tripartite agreements which were not accepted either by the General Assembly or by the United Nations Security Council.

In view of this situation, the Polisario Front faced the invasion while extracting the civilians in danger to neighbour Algeria, who offered them shelter.

Just like that, what was supposed to be a temporary residence has lasted until today.

This year has been sad for the Sahrawi people. The president Mohamed Abdelaziz, a man of peace who devoted his life to fight for the freedom of his people, has passed away. Carrying him in their hearts, the Sahrawi people look to the future with hope. The youth is claiming to be heard, a youth that knows how to combine the traditional values of the Sahrawi culture with the challenges of a modern, globalized world.

Let's turn Vilanova i la Geltru, 41 years later, into an opportunity to rectify the betrayal and the abandonment caused, and continue to work, as usual, in the search for a solution that ensures the self-determination of the Sahrawi people.
