



The Egypt Parliament Abroad:

Against Death Sentences

Oppressive practices in Egypt have increased at an unprecedented pace since the July 2013 military coup that overthrew Egypt's first democratically-elected civilian president. The increasing number of extremely harsh politically-motivated court rulings reflects the tendencies of the military administration dominating government in Egypt toward the elimination of freedom and imposing an atmosphere of injustice and blatant violations to the rights of all Egyptians.

Thus, the Egyptian Parliament Abroad announces its rejection of all these oppressive fascist procedures against Egyptians, especially the wrongful death sentences against hundreds of anti-coup citizens; thirteen are currently awaiting their executions.

The Egypt Parliament Abroad supports all human rights efforts aiming at the elimination of injustice towards all Egyptians whose only crime has been rejecting this military coup and its devastating consequences.

We call upon all parliaments representing the conscience of their peoples to stand in solidarity with this case and pressure their governments to reject injustice and to take a clear stand against these politically-motivated wrongful rulings.
