Hence, on the occasion of the 2018 International Women's Day, the EP's Committee on Women's Rights and Gender Equality (FEMM) would like to invite Members of the National Parliaments of the EU Member States to attend an interparliamentary committee meeting on the theme:

"Empowering Women and Girls in Media and Information and Communication Technologies": Key for the future"

The topic of empowering women and girls in media and Information and Communication Technologies (ICTs) retains global importance and is one that allows for in-depth examination.
