



**Election Day and Deployment**

On Election Day, Members will generally work in teams of two. You will find a list of the locations where we anticipate sending observers, as well as relevant accommodation and travel suggestions. Please note that additional locations may be suggested depending upon developments in coming weeks. **Therefore, we ask observers NOT to make specific travel arrangements (transportation/hotels) within Turkey without first consulting with the International Secretariat.** This will help to ensure balanced deployment coverage for the observation mission.

**Interpreter / Driver on Election Day**

Further information on arrangements for cars/drivers and interpreters for our teams for Election Day will be communicated in due time. Please let the Secretariat know if your Embassy in Turkey will provide Members with a car or/and an interpreter during the Election Day.

**Visa Information**

We strongly advise observers to apply and obtain a visa well in advance of departing for Turkey by contacting the relevant consulate. Attached is the invitation to the OSCE Parliamentary Assembly, welcoming an observation mission.

We would like to remind you that national parliaments are responsible for their own Member's expenses, including any hotel cancellations. **We also urge Members to have health and travel insurance that is valid in Turkey.**
