The EU Turkey Civic Commission (EUTCC) together with the Kurdish Institutes Brussels-Koln- and Stockholm and Network of Kurdish Academics (KURD-AKAD) will hold an International Conference on *The Turkish Invasion in Kurdistan & Kurdish Academics Discuss Their Vision for A Democratic Solution to The Crisis in The Middle East.*

We are writing this letter to invite you to the International Conference which is organized in cooperation with the political groups in European Parliament, *The Progressive Alliance of Socialists and Democrats (S&D), European United Left–Nordic Green Left (GUE-NGL) and The Greens-European Free Alliance (Greens-EFA).*

The AKP government's attacks on the Kurds have expanded beyond Turkey's borders and into North Syria (Rojava) and South Kurdistan (Northern Iraq). Under the pretext of attacking the Islamic State (ISIS) in Syria, Turkey has launched attacks on Kurdish defence groups fighting ISIS.

The Turkish state is maintaining its age-old policy against the Kurds and Kurdistan, aiming to leave the Kurds without any rights yet again.

With the support of most of the Kurdish political parties in all parts of Kurdistan and Kurdish Academics, the EUTCC with its co-partners in the European Parliament wishes to discuss these problems and to explore the possible solutions. The conference will focus on perspectives for a democratic transformation of the Middle East.
