Note Verbale

In a Note No. 62 dated August 12th, 1953, the Embassy of the United States of America advised the Ministry for Foreign Affairs of the desire of the U.S. Air Force to change the location of the proposed new defence area on the ice cap of Greenland from 75° North - 40° West to 71° North - 40° West.

In reply, the Ministry for Foreign Affairs has the honour to inform the Embassy that the Royal Government has no objection to the establishment of the proposed defence area in the new location subject to the provisions set forth in the Ministry's Note Verbale of October 25th, 1952. It is understood that a request for permission to conduct the on-site surveys to determine the exact geographical location of the station will be made as far in advance as possible.
