MAST NORTHERN COASTS 2019 in Copenhagen 3.-6. September 2019 will be the biggest military equipment exhibition and conference in Denmark ever.

It will coincide with Exercise NORTHERN COASTS - 30-35 navy ships' visit in central Copenhagen (some 10 min. direct transport from MAST)

About 4,000 participants - chiefs of navies, Defence Ministry officials, Procurement officials, key defence operators, technologists, and industry from all over the World - will over three days meet keynote and plenary addresses from top level international military and government officials and attend technical presentations on a broad range of topics key to global naval/air operations and technologies. The conference is chaired by the former Chief of Defence Denmark, admiral Tim Sloth Jørgensen. The admiral is appointed as Chairman, MAST Technical Conference Committee. MAST NORTHERN COASTS 2019 organizers will coordinate closely with the navies and ships taking part to enhance the MAST experience during the week. This entails that some of the hosted ship/system tours will be "themed" to MAST-specific conference streams, e.g. MCM, ASW, missile defence, etc., and thus become an integral part of the MAST conference and exhibition program.

Hosted VIPs are expected from over twenty nations and there will be numerous opportunities – especially for sponsoring organizations – to engage with these highly influential stakeholders within the confines of the event areas and at the numerous organizer-arranged social functions.
