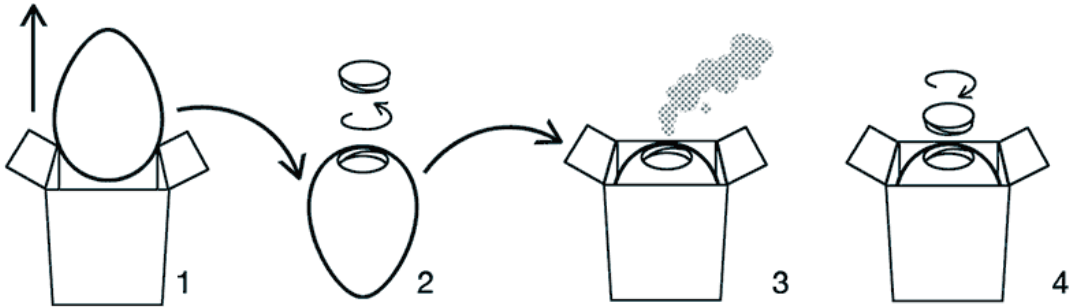

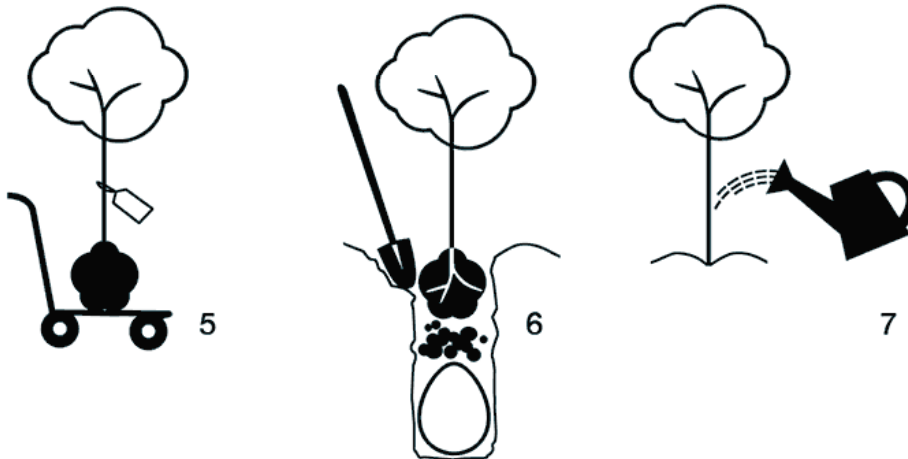


The urn may be interred adjacent to an existing tree or under the new tree you have chosen.



1) Remove the urn from the box. 2) Turn it over and unscrew the bottom plate. 3) Re-insert the urn in the box to keep it vertical while filling it up with the ashes. 4) Screw the bottom plate into the urn and turn over to original position for transportation.

The tree is not included in the shipment.



5) Purchase your tree of choice at your local plant nursery (we recommend selecting trees in accordance with local climatic conditions). 6) Dig a hole in the ground measuring 70 cm in depth (28 inches) and at least 30 cm in width (12 inches). Place the Capsula Mundi urn at the bottom of the hole and fill it with soil, leaving enough space to house the root ball. After placing the tree, fill the hole with soil to ground level. 7). Ensure the tree's health and growth by providing water... and love!

To those who choose to place their urn next to an existing tree: dig a hole measuring 50 cm in depth (20 inches) and at least 30cm in width (12 inches). Place the Capsula Mundi urn in the hole and cover it with soil to reach ground level.
