The inaugural Antarctic Parliamentarians Assembly took place in London this week and it was an incredibly successful first event.

19 parliamentary delegates from 13 countries reached a consensus on an extensive conference statement (see attached). Some countries that were unable to send parliamentarians were represented on the day by Embassy delegations, which resulted in a total of 18 signatories to the Antarctic Treaty taking part in the discussions.
