With this in mind, I would like to extend an invitation of the Government of Georgia to the OSCE Parliamentary Assembly to monitor the 2020 parliamentary elections in Georgia. The Georgian side will additionally notify the OSCE Parliamentary Assembly on the exact date of the elections once the formal announcement is made.

Meanwhile, let me assure you that the Georgian side is ready to receive the Election Observation Mission at your earliest convenience. Let me express our full readiness to provide all the necessary support to the election observers from the OSCE Parliamentary Assembly to effectively perform their tasks and duties in Georgia.
